Planting a "Pick Up for Church Ministry" in Your Church.

MISSION STATEMENT

(How to reach the lost ,and *Double* Your Church Attendance Annually. .By Creating a mindset and Church Culture of, "reaching your circle of influence", and picking them up for Church.

I Want to give you 3 categories of STATISTICS regarding what's going on with the evangelical Church in America.

CATEGORY 1; of Statistics

This sobering, first one, burdens me the most, then I wanted to give you the solution.

Statistics are from Charisma Magazine, internet Church Growth Data, and 18 years working with Pastors Tommy Barnett and Pastor Mathew Barnett's Pastor's Schools.

THE STATISTICS

An average 150 churches are being shutdown **EVERY WEEK** in the USA.

64% of all American Churches are on the decline.

The America Church now decreases at 3% per year.

"Per-capita" The Gay Rights Movement, is increasing faster than Christianity, and has an Agenda to make all Christian Bibles oillegal. <u>Unless things change</u>, at this present rate, in 15 years All American pastors will lose their nonprofit status if they refuse to marry a same-sex couple. <u>In 20 years it will be illegal for anyone to own a Bible</u>.

"Per-capita", The Islam faith is increasing faster then Christianity with a Violent, blood shed ,agenda ,to eradicate all Christianity. <u>Unless things change</u>, in 25 years, they will accomplish their goal.

88% of all church in America are made up of members that <u>MIGRATE</u> from other Churches.(In other words, the lost are not being reached)

CATEGORY 2; Of Statistics, (Is the obvious reason for church decline).

95% Of the American Christians have never lead 1 person to Christ their entire life.

98% Of all American Christians do you not know how too intelligently explain the gospel with love and humility.

Other than Christmas and Easter, 80% all American Christians have never picked up 1 lost person for Church.

97% of all American Pastors admit that they have never taught their congregations how to reach the lost and build there churches.

75% of believers believe that they will Become stagnate and stop growing Spiritually if they are not involved Reaching the lost and or, making Disciples.

(Before the solution),

FIRST: MY BACKGROUND

For 18 years I had the privilege of being a full-time pastor, <u>trained</u> under Pastor Tommy Barnett and Pastor Mathew Barnett at the LA Dream Center. For 18 years I taught a class at the annual "TOMMY BARNETT PASTOR'S SCHOOL". (For those 18 years) i got to observe first hand how they <u>reached the lost</u> and <u>built Churches</u>.

; Phenox First Assembly

Grew from 75 members to 22,500 members (Most of which I observed)

They planted over 100 Dream Centers world wide, give 8 million dollars annually to overseas missions, and have planted an estimated 500 churches with multiple Bible colleges.

: LA Dream Center

Grew from 100 members to 9,000 members, and caused the crime rate to reduce by 70% in the Eco Park community (All of which I observed)

What's <u>very very</u> important is that <u>80%</u> of their congregations are made up of the <u>Lost Being Saved</u>, or the <u>Unchurched</u>, from their neighbors.

CATEGORY 3; Of Statistics, (Revealing the Solution)

Billy Gram admitted sadly , that only 3% of all those that go forward at his crusades ever make it into the church.

In comparison 87% of all lost that recieve salvation and are successfully planted, In a church, is because of one factor.

That **factor** is, because people in the church are motivated and trained to <u>pick them up for church</u>.

<u>STATISTICS TELL US</u>; If you pick up a person 4 times. Then 40% will not only go on with their walk with the Lord Jesus Christ, they will become an active member of the church.

Then If that new 40% are invited, to be a part of the "pick up for church ministry", and taught the procedure, or steps, they will bring in an average of 6 of their <u>unsaved</u> circle of influence, into the church. Then the new 6 will be invited and trained to do the same.

You can see how the <u>multiplication of converts</u> works. You can see how your church <u>will</u> double annually, and reach the lost.

You can see how "Phoenix First Assembly" went from 75 members to 22,500 members.

1. Share the vision with the Pastor

He must be 100% Sold out to the vision.

You must agree to Pray for, and celebrate the ministry at least 5 minutes each Sunday morning, and or, mid week service.

The congregation must know He has a word from the Lord and is 100% committed to this ministry.

- 2. Pastor must share the vision with his wife and Staff and get them behind it.
- 3. Pastor must share at least three messages on The biblical viewpoint of reaching the lost. **Some Examples of this are.** Following Jesus's example To reach the lost . What the Scriptures commanded us to do regarding reaching a lost. The reality of a Hell to miss at all cost, and The **life and death** importance of Rescuing as many as you can from that destiny. (Some scriptures on this topic will be provided).
- 4. The church must be willing to provide the following.
- (A). A modest budget to do the weekly "random acts of kindness".
- (B). Set up a guest welcomeing, recording, and Follow up system for newcomers.
- (This involves a house visitation, Or restaurant meal ,within one week) here, the gospel is explained , and a pick up for church arrangements is astablished.
- (C) Church must be prepared to help fund participants to take guests out to lunch after church. (Statistics tell that if a visitor doesn't make a good relationship in their first visit 95% of the time they will never return.)
- 5. At the end of the 3rd teaching on studying the **Bible viewpoint of reaching the lost** the pastor will briefly explain the Pick up for Church Ministry ,to his congregation.

This is turning point for the congregations willingness to make the commitment.

A suggestion is to explain how the following;

God not only calls us to tithe our money but our time. God will bless us for giving our time just like giving financially .

Explain how, unless God is telling you otherwise then we highly encourage you to make the first six month commitment .Explain there is no condemnation, or false guilt, if God is leading you

not participate. Or you can participate by being a prayer warrior and/or financial support. But we always must declare war on our comfort zone.

The pastor can ask,; "if you do not have other commitments then ask how many of you would believe God for six months Commitment. This would be to start with and then keep an open mind and heart to keep it going after the six mouths."

6. The pastor explains the participation card and passes it out. He ask the congregation to pray over the card and fill it out and bring it back for the next service, which is the 4th service.

For those that forget to fill out the card or bring it back to the next service. The pastor will have extra cards and then he will take time for the cards to be filled out in service., Say about 10 minutes.

7. Here is how the pastor explains the (participation card).

- (1) Each person chooses a partner they're comfortable working and praying with.
- (After church At the end of the third service they should briefly meet together to agree that they are working together)
- (2) The pastor asked Everyone to pray over there (Circle of Influence) , The Greek word is ${\color{red} {\bf OIKOS}}$.

Their circle of influence come from 3 groups.

One. Family and Relatives. Number two. Friends. Number three. Casual Acquaintances. You pray and ask God for a (prioritized 7) that He wants you to approach to set Up (a pick up for church arrangement). List them on your card

The pastor explains That the commitment involved two Sundays a month bringing at least one Person to church.

- (3) Ask God for a strategy to set up A pick up for church arrangement for each of the 7. (Write it down on the card after each of the 7).
- (3A) it is also very important to have a back up substitute person to pick up. 1/4 of the time The person you arrange to pick up will back out at the last minute. So it is important to have one person in mind that you could call and arrange to pick up a back up if your first person failed, of backed out.
- (4) Ask God which one's you could approach To set up a **house visitation** or a **restaurant meal**. Note; (A trained captain will go with you). Mark a Yes or No on your card after each one.
- (You set up a house visitation, for a restaurant meal, by contacting one of your 7. Use them explain that your church has a program where they come to your house and **pray a blessing over your home** and or **your family**. We also let them know what we provide as a church.

You will bring a cooked chicken and trimmings.(also we suggest bringing a bouquet of flowers for the wife)

(Explain to them that it would really mean everything to you, to have the honor and the privilege of doing this.)

If people are not comfortable with you coming to their house invite them to a restaurant, your treat. You may also consider inviting them to your house if you feel they would come.

(Later on we will explain how a trained caption will use this to lead them to salvation and set up a pick up for church arrangement.)

(5). Pray and right on the back of the card, 2 or more outreaches that you would commit to do each month. Each outreach is about two hours, however you can stay longer if you desire.

Fun, Random acts of Kindness, are from 10 AM to 12 o'clock **each Saturday** and 3 o'clock **on each Wednesday** For high schools . For high schools we also have outreaches at noon, about every day.

The different kinds of outreaches and will be listed on the card and you can select which ones you want to do and on which days. If you want to you can set up your own outreaches As long as you have a trained leader.

If you can do a house **visitation** or a **restaurant meal**. We usually do those on Saturday evening and, or , Sunday evening.

If you desire you can indicate this on the bottom of your card.

(When you have finished your card your team captain will take a picture of your card)

- **8.** At the beginning of the <u>4th meeting</u>. The Pastor Introduces our team. And share his passion and belief in the "pick up for church ministry" and the "fun random acts of kindness".
- 9. Our team bring a hard-hitting motivational message ,the importance of reaching the lost ,and the need for empowerment of the Holy Spirit.

Then we have them stop and finish filling out the cards. That's about eight minutes. We finish bye further explaining how the program works. We go through it step-by-step. We finish the service we are sharing the need for <u>Holy Spirit and empowerment</u> Of the Holy Spirit. With the Pastor's permission we lay hands on people for impartation.

10. With the <u>5th service</u> we finish the teaching on how to work the system. We give them 10 minutes To work on their participation card and pray over their 7 with their partner.

Next we explain how to clearly and intelligently explain the gospel. We teach on how to to approach an unknown person and then to lead them to the Lord. We teach on how to set up a pick up for church arrangement. We **emphasize using a politeness but not** taking no for an **answer.** We explain step-by-step how to do a home vistation and/or restaurant meal. We Explain how to explain the gospel in a comfortable powerful way and then to set up a pick up for church arrangements.

We explain how to do the fun random acts of kindness, And how this open up the door and you clearly explain the gospel set up a pick up for church arrangements.

We conclude by announcing announce the next Training session followed by the outreach.

- 11. Our team stays on for a minimum of two months to lead outreaches. And during that time we train teams and appoint and train team captains with the pastors recommendation.
- 12. It is important for the pastor to celebrate the pick up for church Ministry and the fun, random acts of kindness at every server.
- (1) He does this by 3 things, 1 he welcomes, acknowledges, and thanks the guests. 2 He thanks and makes a big deal about those who brought the guests. 3 he gets a short fast happy testimony from somebody that did the Random acts of Kindness. The Pastor has them explain how they did it.
- (2)He gets the addresses of the guests by giving out a gift and a response, address, card. When they turn in the card in the back table of the church in the foyer, a greater greets them and gives them another gift like a coffee mug or a Starbucks gift card.
- (3)We Tex them within two days, And thank them for coming and I asked them if there's anything we can pray with them for.

Next you call or Tex (calling works better), within two weeks. We Explain to them how it is our church practice to do a house visitation to pray a blessing over their house and family, or a restaurant meal. Again we use this to **explain the gospel** and set up **a pick up for church arrangement.**

Fun, Random Acts of Kindness, Outreach

The Objective of these events is to open the door 1. Clearly explain the gospel followed by leading a person to salvation, and 2. Set up a pick up for church Arrangement.

Each person will pick at least 2, "Fun, Random Act of Kindness".(Try to choose at least two a month)

They will put a check On the graph below after each day they want to commit.

(A suggestive list of random acts of kindness) or (RAK).

- 1. Outreach to High Schools and Middle Schools, RAK. (Buying hamburgers, using 7 things booklet ,interview questionnaire) (This one is held Each Wednesday where kids hang out after school. It's usually McDonald's at 3 PM.)
- 2. Outreach to Skate Board Parks. RAK.(Taking water bottles and pizza) (This one is usually held the <u>First Saturday</u> of each month and from 10 AM till 12:30. At local skate board parks).
- 3. Outreach to Basket ball Parks. RAK. (Taking water bottles and pizza.). (This one is usually held the same time as the skateboard park Outreach).
- 4. Outreach to Kids and Parents at Parks RAK. (Take games, toys, raffle tickets). (This one is usually held at the <u>Second Saturday</u> of every month from 10 AM 12:30.

 It is usually held at the local park).
- 5. Outreach to Neighborhood. Going door-to-door with appreciation gifts. RAK (Take appreciation gift such as figurine or nice bag of food) (This one is usually held the *Third Saturday* of each month, 10 am 12:30).
- 6. Free car wash. (Give out toys, water bottles, do interview questionnaire with 7 things pamphlet.) This one usually goes On the <u>Fourth Saturday</u> of each month From 10 AM till 12:30. The location could be the church parking lot or a filling station etc.)
 7. Laundromat love. (. Pay for their laundromat while doing a short interview questionnaire and seven playing pamphlet.) (This one can usually be substituted in, in place of , the free car

THE FOLLOWING ARE OTHER SUGGESTIONS FOR "Fun ,Random Acts of Kindness."

1. Collect used clothing from neighborhoods to help the homeless. Have them meet you at the church before Sunday morning with the closing. Use this as the or portunity to invite them to church and get to know them.

2. Do a free Yard sale for your neighbors. Mark and price their stuff with them. Then sell their stuff and give them all the money. Use this to get to know your neighbors and arrange a pick up for church arrangements or and/or set up a time to explain the gospel.
