(Note): This Outline is to be studied with the teaching on the website "How to Lead a Person to the Lord"

We Call this approach "Prayer evangelism using the, "Eternal Question"

Try to memorize this and have your workers also memorize it.

Here is an easy strategy to share the gospel and lead people to the Lord.

It involves setting up a table with a few chairs, and/or a banner or poster, on the sidewalk or where the kids pass by after school.

Poster might say free pizza and Bibles.



Give out your free <u>Pizza</u> and <u>Bibles</u>, <u>Literature</u>, etc., <u>Bible comic books</u> etc and And do what I call is <u>prayer evangelism</u>.

This means, (as a Spirt leads), ask people if they're hungry? Give out some pizza and then ask people if you can say a "blessing prayer" for them.



Ask if there's anything you could pray with them about. Make a mental note of it then ask them how you can <u>pray for them</u>.

Say, "Can I ask you a personal question?" God forbid, But, "Do you have that complete assurance in your heart that if you died today, that your spirit would go to be with God in heaven??"

Wait for a response, then say God says in his word,

"That his Spirt will bear witness with your spirit God that you are God's Children." We call this the "eternal question."

**Romans 8:16** 



Say, "Let's pray for your needs, but could I lead you in a prayer to make Jesus your main man, forgive you, and cleanse you for every wrong or sin."

Then, Lead them in the Salvation Prayer and Repentance.

-Romans 10: 9-10

Then remember to Pray for their needs.

Give each person a Bible



Thank them and tell them that you will never call them. Instead, send them a text message and tell them where a local youth group, Bible study church, or Bible club, is on campus, etc.

Following this strategy can lead a person to the Lord.

This approach works when people are in a hurry and don't have time for you to capture quality time and sit down with them.

- Remember always to be polite and not pushy.
- Remember, "People don't care how much you know. Until they know how much you care!!"
- Always remember to follow up by sending them a text message.
- Thank them and ask them if there is anything they need prayer for, if they have any questions, or if you can pick them up for a meeting.
