


# KING OF KINGS

*The Bible in Pictures*





Long before there was a planet, a great plan was set in motion that involves all of us living today.




Somewhere in the outer reaches of space was a tremendous light and power source composed of three distinct personalities. The Bible claims each Person to be the only true and living God. It was here this plan originated.

The Holy Scriptures call these three personalities the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost (God, the Holy Spirit). This is known as the Godhead.

1 John 5:7\* ... "For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one."

The number two Person of the Godhead was given the job to create the vast universe. His name was called "The Word"... He spoke and the galaxies came into existence.

John 1:1-3

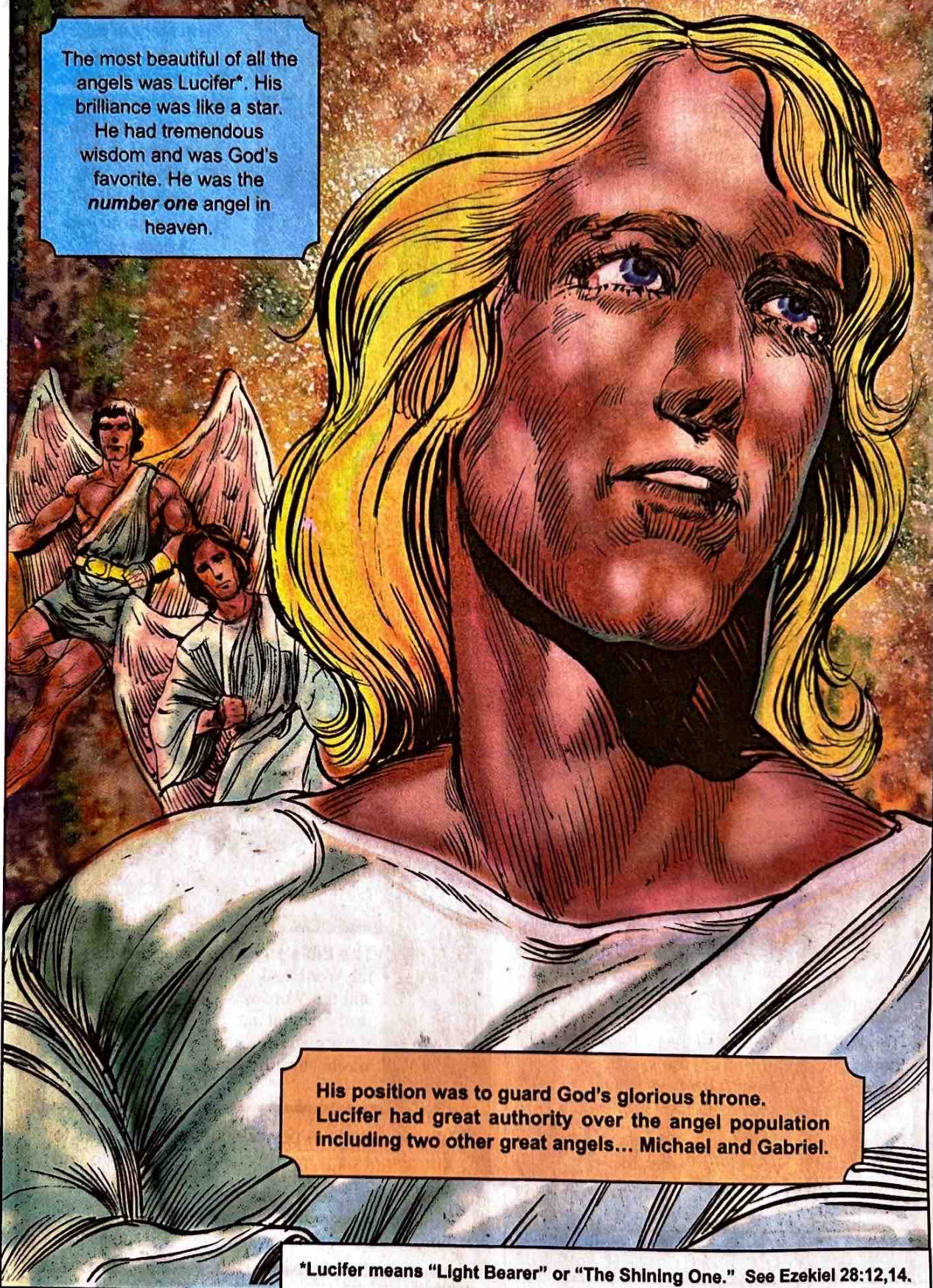
This tremendous power source later comes to our planet as a man. You'll be shocked to find out His name.

"The Word," who is the Lord Jesus Christ, created millions of angels to serve God up in heaven. These angels were magnificent creatures with great strength, wisdom and power... all of them were loyal to God and loved Him. Colossians 1:16-17

The most beautiful of all the angels was Lucifer\*. His brilliance was like a star. He had tremendous wisdom and was God's favorite. He was the *number one* angel in heaven.



His position was to guard God's glorious throne. Lucifer had great authority over the angel population including two other great angels... Michael and Gabriel.

\*Lucifer means "Light Bearer" or "The Shining One." See Ezekiel 28:12,14.

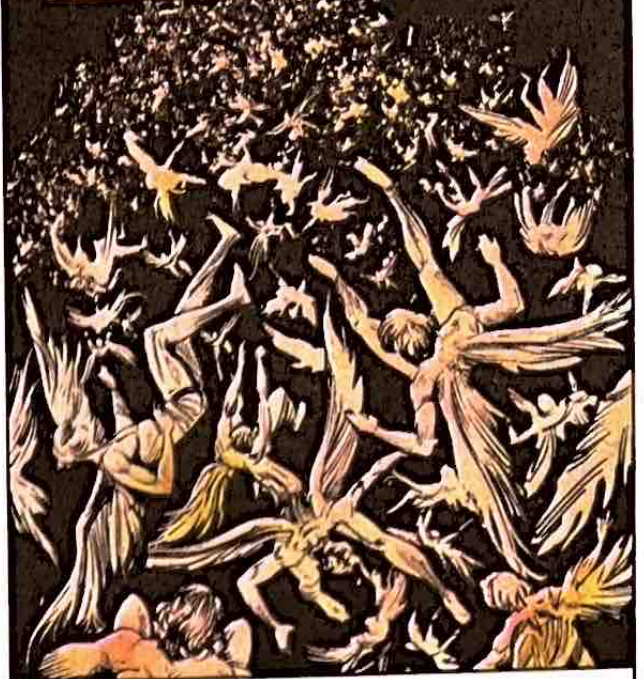

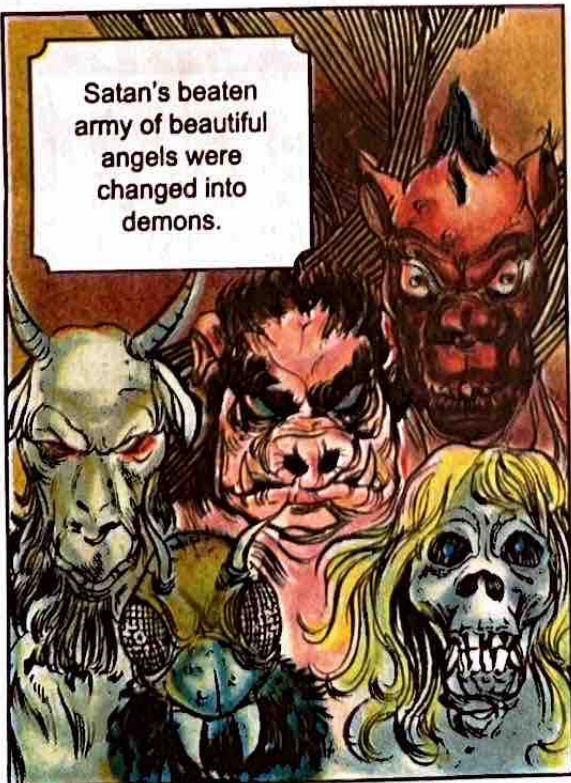
In his insanity, Lucifer forgot he was only a created being. God ordered Lucifer, and the angels who had joined him in this evil plan, thrown out of heaven.



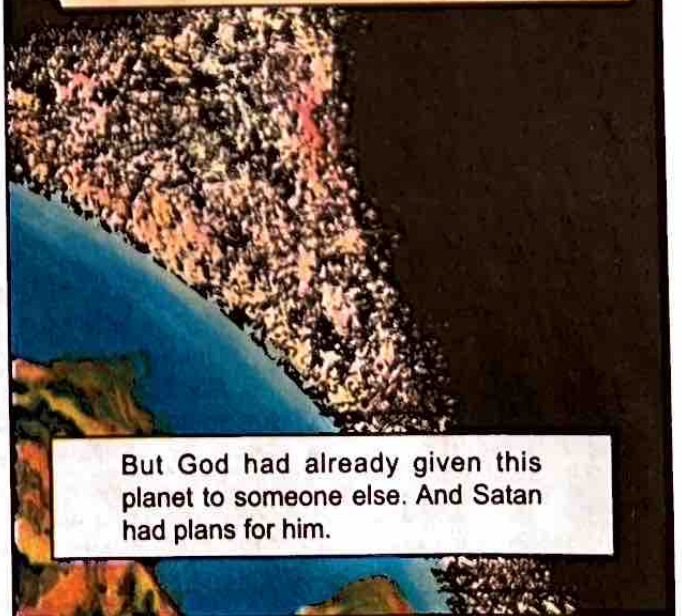

But God had already given this planet to someone else. And Satan had plans for him.





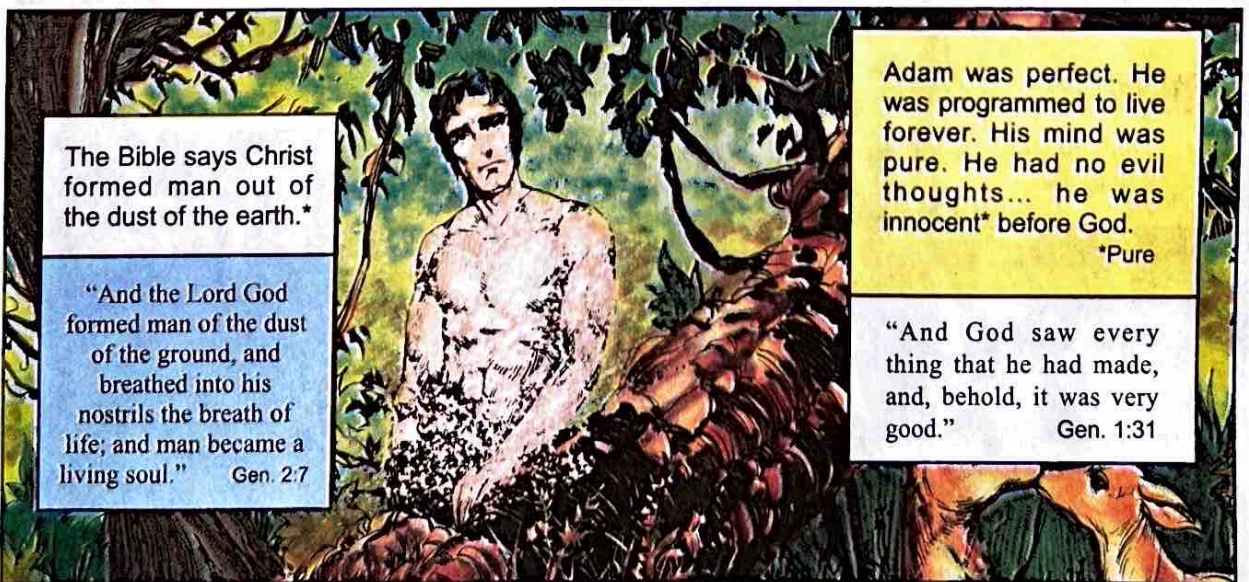
Satan claimed the earth for himself. He was determined to destroy this rival.

But this creature called "man" was so important that the entire Godhead got involved in his creation.

\*Pure

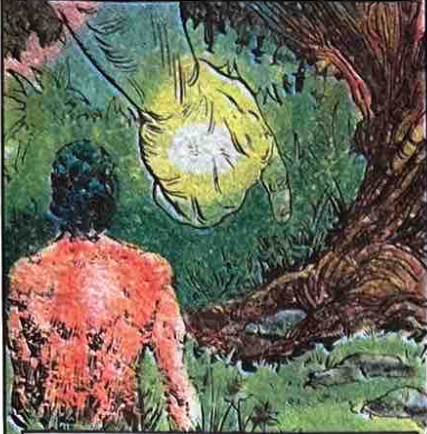
"And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good." Gen. 1:31

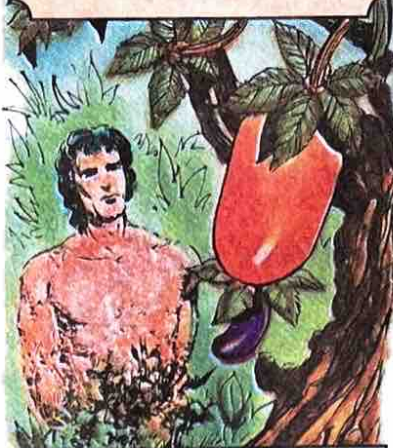


God gave Adam a direct order\* not to eat of the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. And Adam got the message. \*Genesis 2:17



He knew if he ate of this tree he would surely die.

The knowledge of good and evil was strictly forbidden. Either you must live with good or with evil. You cannot live with both.



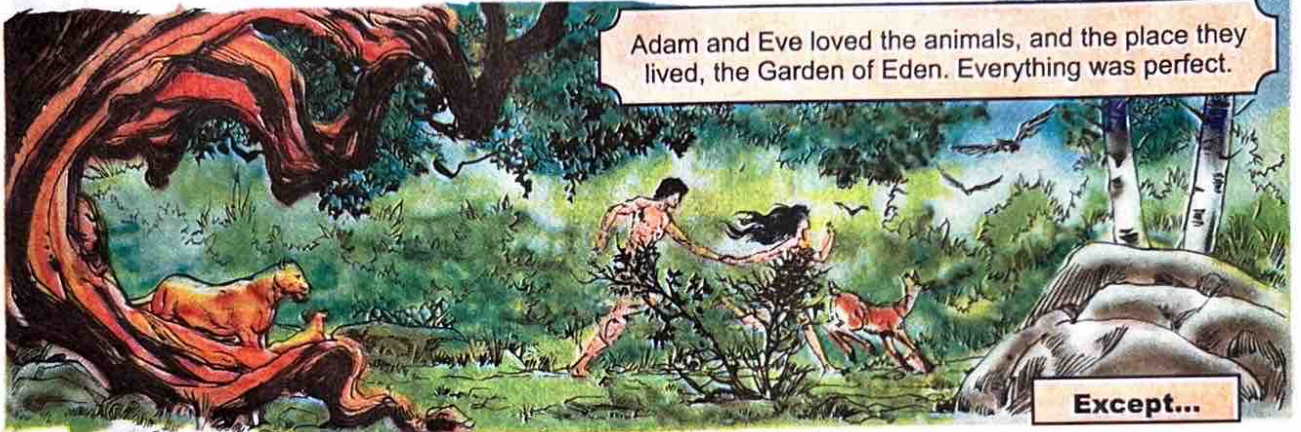
God demanded total separation. God did this to protect Adam.

The Lord Jesus created Eve. He put Adam into a deep sleep and formed Eve from one of his ribs. Genesis 2:22



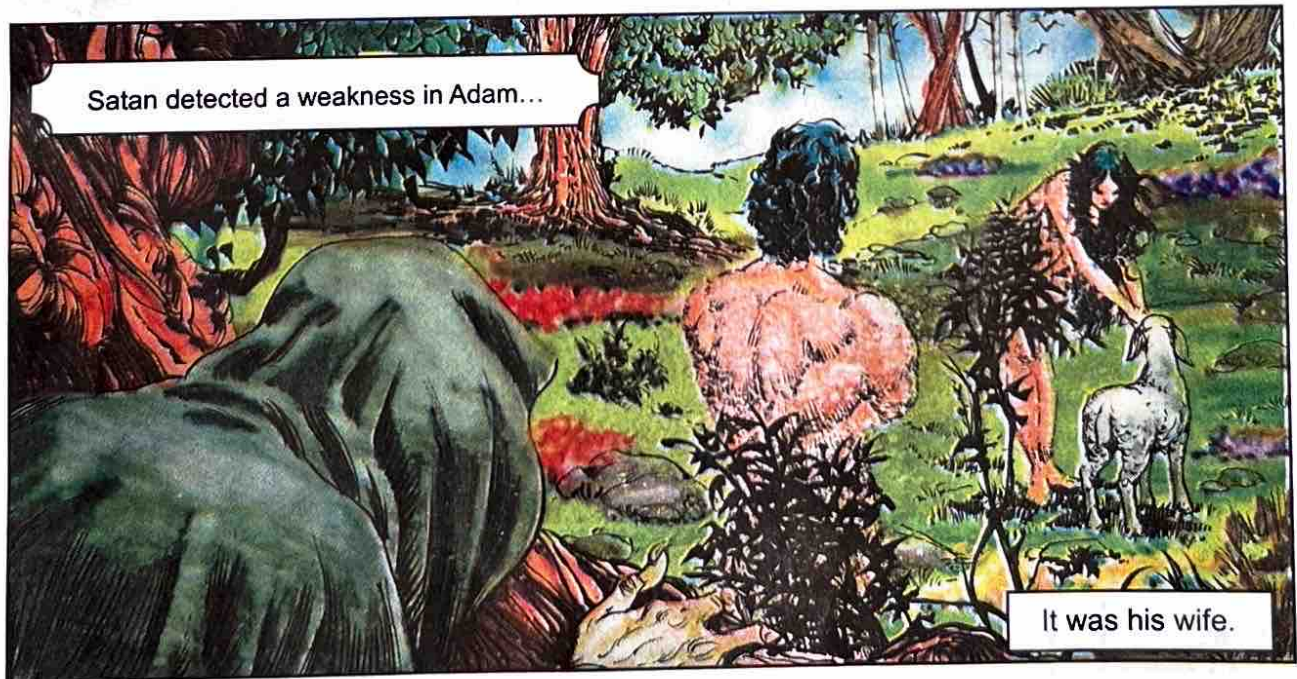
She, too, was perfect. Both glowed from God's glory. Adam loved Eve. God was their friend.

Adam and Eve loved the animals, and the place they lived, the Garden of Eden. Everything was perfect.



Except...

Satan detected a weakness in Adam...



It was his wife.



Satan wanted to talk to Eve in the garden... one of the creatures in there was called a serpent\*... so Satan entered into the serpent and possessed it, and talked through the serpent to Eve.

Eve was fascinated by its conversation.

He didn't approach Adam because Adam had named every animal in the garden and he would have recognized that this creature had been invaded by an outside force.

Eve didn't understand, nor did she check Satan out. This was his big chance!

\*Before its fall, the serpent was the most beautiful and subtle creature next to man. (Gen. 3:1) After Adam and Eve sinned, God cursed the serpent and it had to crawl on its belly in the dust. (Gen. 3:14)

God had given Adam dominion,\* or control, over the entire world. Satan wanted to throw Adam off his throne, to control the world just like he tried to do to God up in heaven... only this time, Satan won. \*Genesis 1:28

Satan talked Eve into eating the forbidden fruit and gambled that because Adam loved Eve, he would listen to her and also eat of the forbidden fruit...

Adam did it. Satan was overjoyed!



The glorious glow that Adam and Eve had, went out. For the first time they saw their bodies and knew they were naked.\* They had sinned against God.

\*Genesis 3:7

What happened?

I don't know!

**They had died spiritually**

They felt fear for the first time. They covered their bodies with fig leaves.

God appeared and they had to stand before Him in judgment.

A strange thing happens when we sin. We try to blame someone else for it and that's just what Adam did.

God asked Adam...

"Hast (have) thou eaten of the tree whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?" (Genesis 3:11)

Adam tries to make God responsible for the whole thing. He said...

"The woman whom *thou* gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat."\*

\*Genesis 3:12

In other words, Adam said, "It's your fault, God... *You* gave me that woman."

Notice that God laid the major blame on Adam, not Eve. A woman is responsible for her personal relationship with God which includes submission to her husband.

See Genesis 3:17.

God's heart was broken... God had always been their friend but now it was a new ball game. He had to keep His promise.

Suddenly, in front of Adam and Eve stood a holy, righteous God. Now He was their judge and He **had** already sentenced them to death.\*



They had no idea what was coming!

\*Genesis 2:17



The Lord Jesus said to Eve:

"What is this that thou hast done?"\*

God alone knew the terrible chain reaction of hellish problems that would follow because Eve didn't obey.

\*Genesis 3:13

When Eve stood before the Lord, she blamed the serpent. She had no idea the terrible crime that she was involved in... her act affected the life of every man, woman and child that ever lived thereafter.

Adam and Eve, in trying to hide what they had done, used fig leaves... it was not good enough for God.

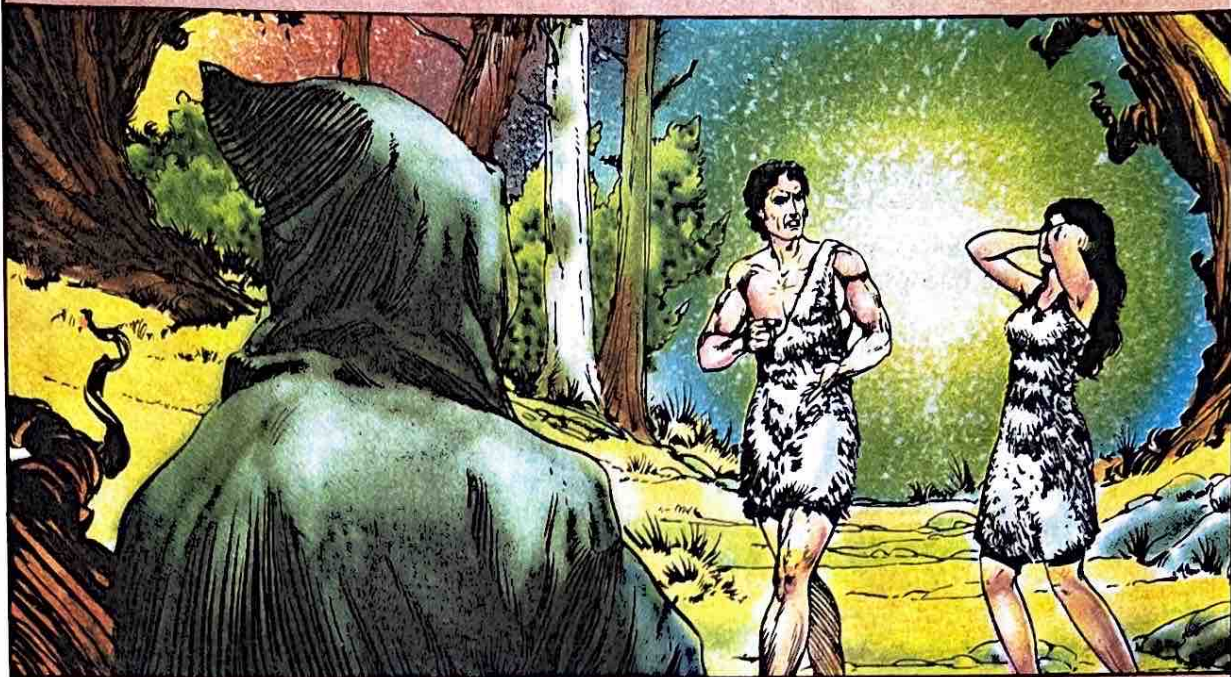
Something had to die for this crime. Some believe that He chose little lambs, something very precious and dear to Adam and Eve. These lambs were killed. God took off their fig leaves and covered their bodies with the skins of those lambs.

This involved the shedding of blood.\* They were horrified! For the first time, death was in the Garden of Eden. The friendship they once had with God was now gone. He was no longer their spiritual Father.

\*Hebrews 9:22, Leviticus 17:11b



God ordered them out of the garden. The earth was cursed and evil things came forth, like thorns, disease, insects, wild animals and snakes. Then came hurricanes, earthquakes, wars and cancer. Sin had destroyed everything.



Satan now had legal and spiritual control\* of the world. He became the god of this world. (II Cor. 4:4) Satan commanded his demons to take over the earth and its inhabitants for their new homes. Mankind was ruined.\*\*

Children were born to Adam and Eve. It was a totally new environment... innocence was gone... the firstborn was Cain, then came Abel and then Seth. After this, many more children were born to Adam and Eve.\* Adam lived to be 930 before he died.  
\*Genesis 5:4

\*Luke 4:6 \*\*Romans 5:12

The pattern was set... since Satan now ruled the earth, he became the spiritual father of humanity.\* God shows us a picture of the human heart. It is "...deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked..."\*\* In God's eyes, we have one thing in common. We are all totally depraved (rotten).

In Romans, chapters 1 and 3, the Bible describes our condition like this: (And it's very unpopular to us so-called good people.)

Let's go back to Cain, the firstborn on the earth. Eve thought that Cain would be the answer to all their problems.


I've gotten a man from the Lord.

No doubt, Adam and Eve spent hours complaining about what happened in the Garden of Eden and whose fault it was:

It wasn't a happy family, moaning about what it could have been like, if only they hadn't blown it.

Cain and Abel knew that the price for sinning was death and that they had to kill something that never sinned. The lamb was the animal God chose.



Cain didn't buy it... he would do it his way. No one was going to tell *him* what to do!



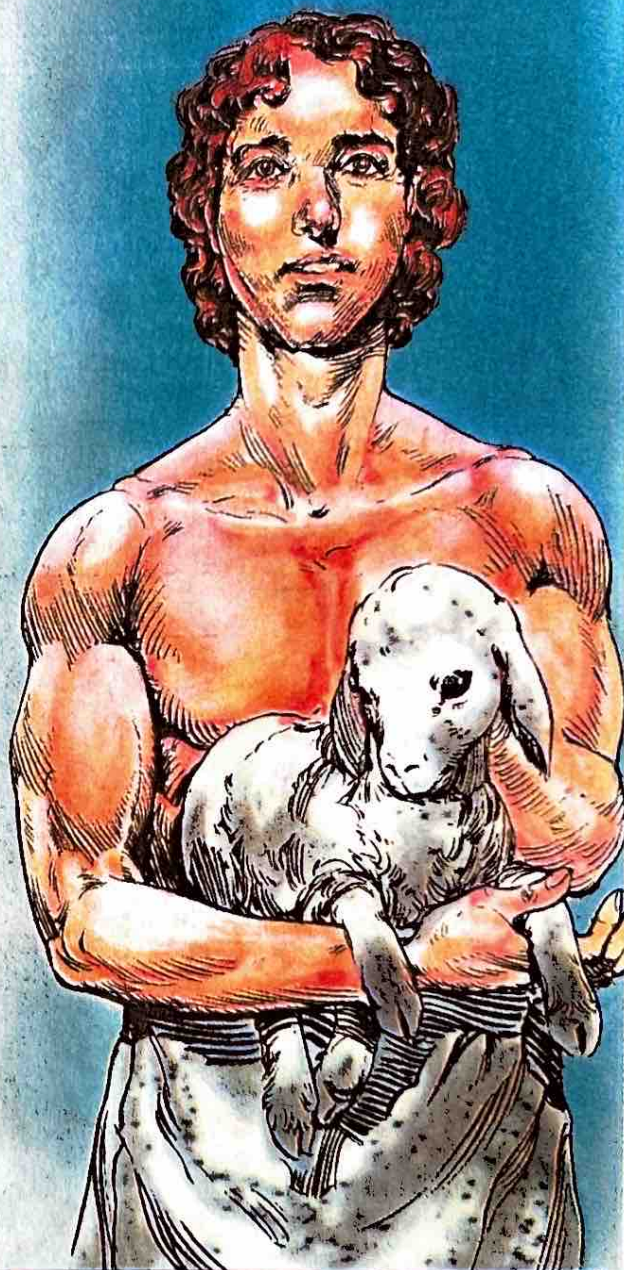
Cain knew what he was supposed to do. When it was time to come before the Lord to offer his sacrifices, Cain tried to pull a fast one. Instead of a lamb...



He brought vegetables before the Lord. Cain had sweated\* in the sun growing them. He was proud of his offering... but God would not accept it. \*Genesis 3:19

“...to obey is better than sacrifice...”  
I Samuel 15:22

His kid brother, Abel, came before the Lord... he wanted to please God and do right, even if it meant Cain being mad at him. Abel feared God more than he feared his brother, Cain.

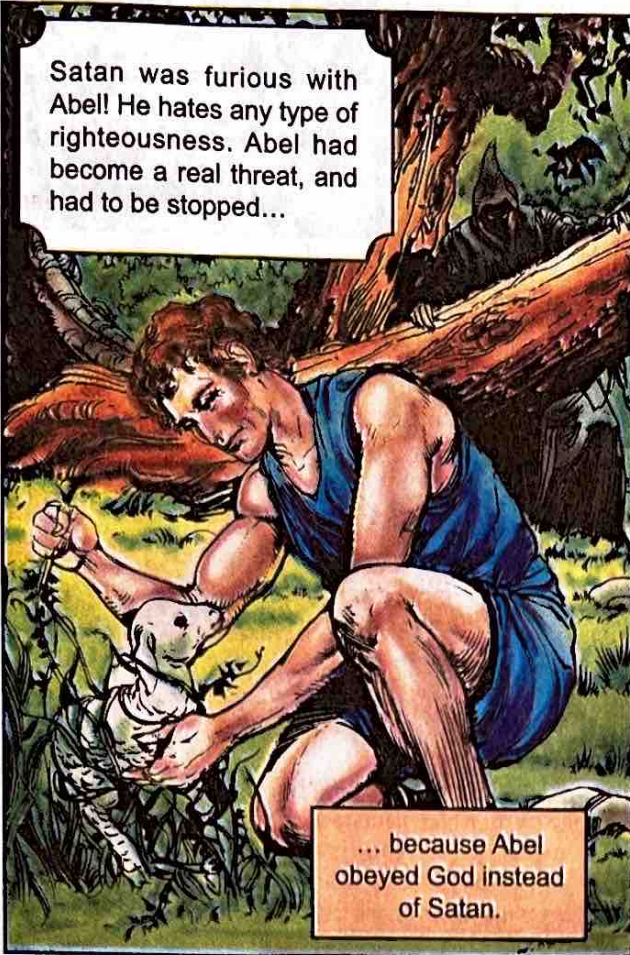


The Bible says: “By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain.” (Heb. 11:4)

So Abel brought the finest lamb he could find. God was pleased. Abel didn't know that it would cost him his life. “Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.” (II Timothy 3:12)

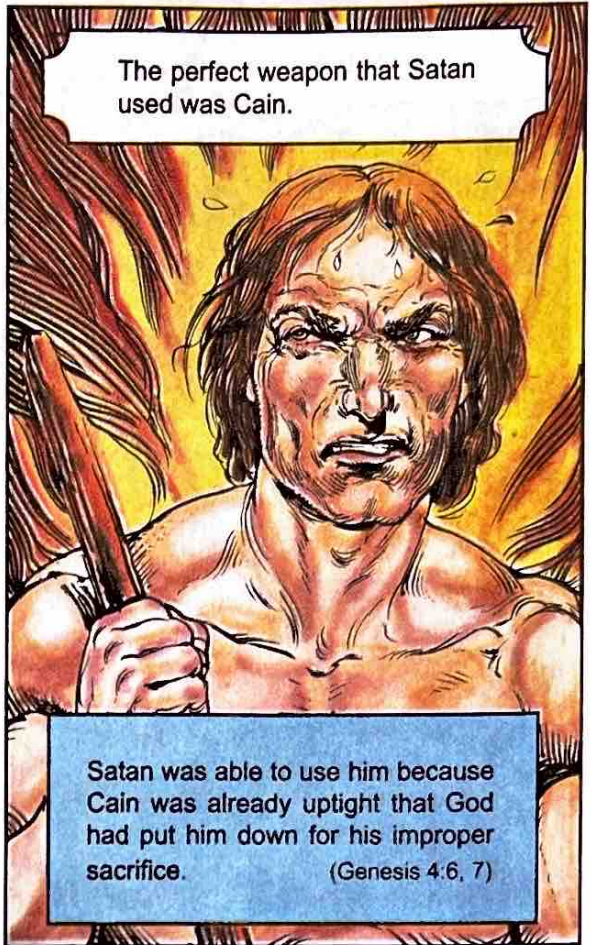


Satan was furious with Abel! He hates any type of righteousness. Abel had become a real threat, and had to be stopped...

The perfect weapon that Satan used was Cain.



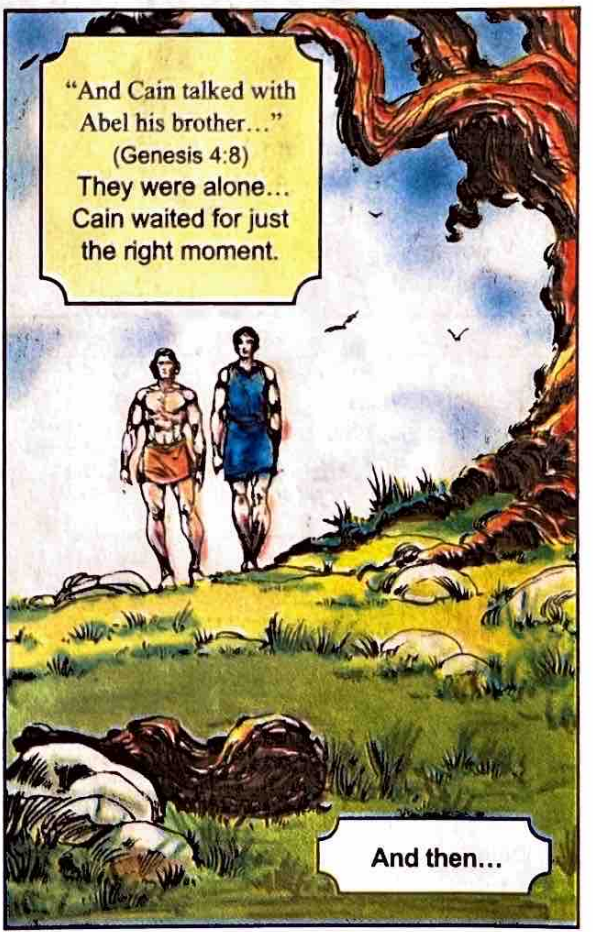
Satan was able to use him because Cain was already uptight that God had put him down for his improper sacrifice. (Genesis 4:6, 7)

Cain waited for just the right moment.



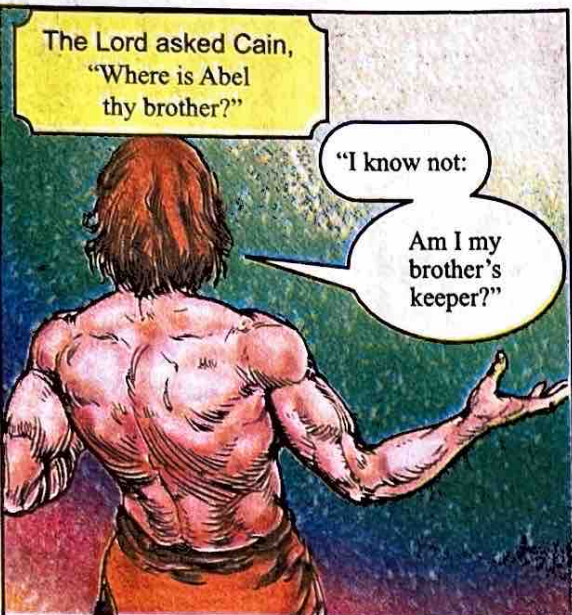
And then...





Cain made the kill!

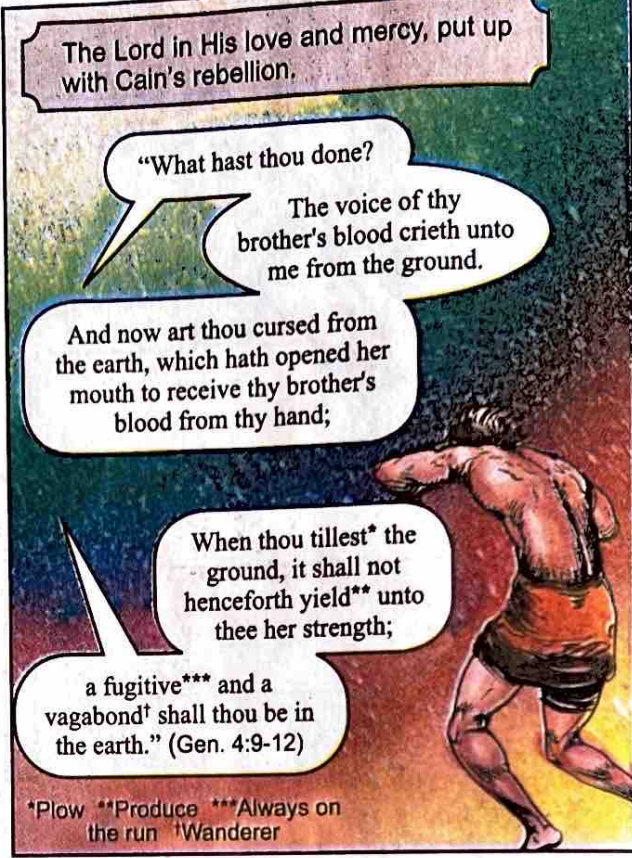
He left the lifeless body of his kid brother lying in the field. Now Cain, the first-born of the earth, was a murderer!



The Lord asked Cain, "Where is Abel thy brother?"

"I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?"

Cain insulted the Lord God of creation with an arrogant and sarcastic lie. He thought he was really something special. He was full of pride. What an idiot! He had no respect at all for authority.



The Lord in His love and mercy, put up with Cain's rebellion.

"What hast thou done? The voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground.

And now art thou cursed from the earth, which hath opened her mouth to receive thy brother's blood from thy hand;

When thou tillest\* the ground, it shall not henceforth yield\*\* unto thee her strength;

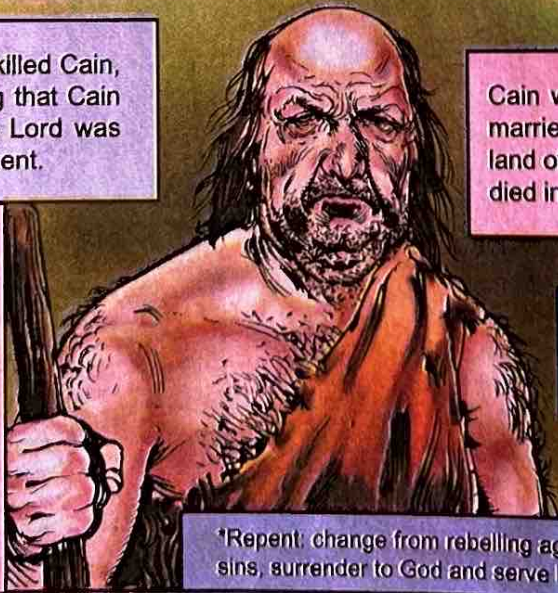
a fugitive\*\*\* and a vagabond† shall thou be in the earth." (Gen. 4:9-12)

God could have instantly killed Cain, but He didn't. It's amazing that Cain had no fear of God. The Lord was giving him a chance to repent.

Cain went away and years later, married one of his sisters in the land of Nod. Cain was a loser and died in his sins, and went to hell.

Cain *never* repented\* for this crime! He was mad at God for the punishment. He thought God was unjust! All he did was kill his brother who was a trouble-maker. So he tried to justify his crime.



The world has been filled with this kind of people ever since.

\*Repent: change from rebelling against God, to be sorry for your sins, surrender to God and serve Him.



The sad thing was, Cain knew all about God!... and he knew what God expected. Cain was deeply religious because he even offered a sacrifice to God.

Cain never said God didn't exist. He believed in God... but Cain *would not* accept God's way. He would not believe that the lamb must die and its blood be shed to satisfy God's anger over sin. It offended Cain. He was a religious fool. Cain had his own religion and it was directed and twisted by Satan.



From this point in history everything really started down hill... the world's population started growing. Occasionally someone would be born who obeyed God, like Seth. About 7 generations later another righteous one was born by the name of Enoch.

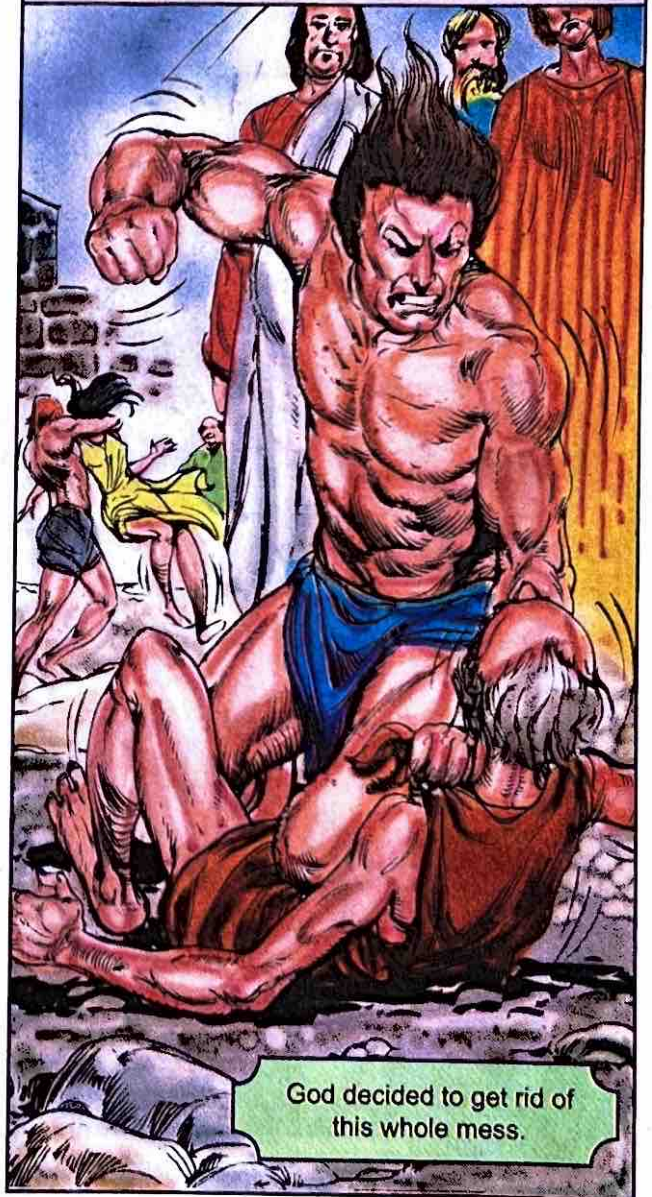

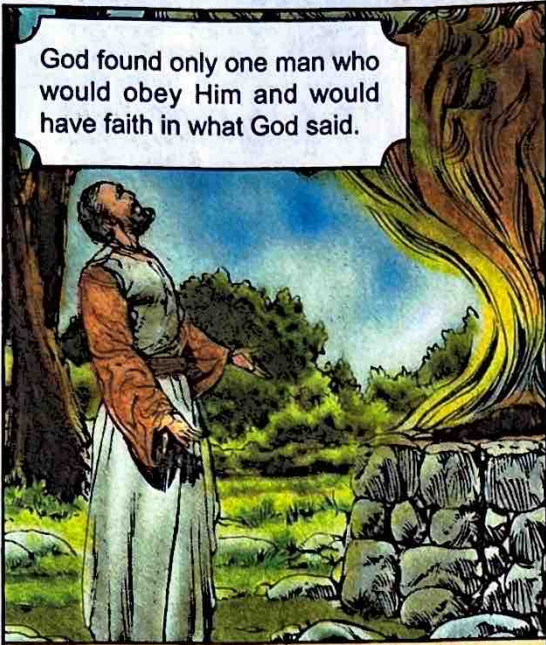

God decided to get rid of this whole mess.

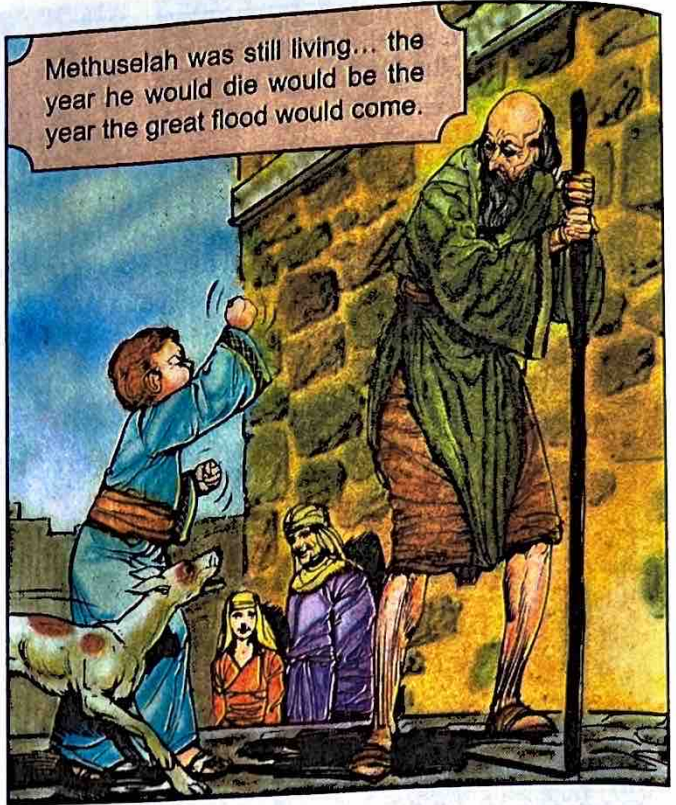


God found only one man who would obey Him and would have faith in what God said.

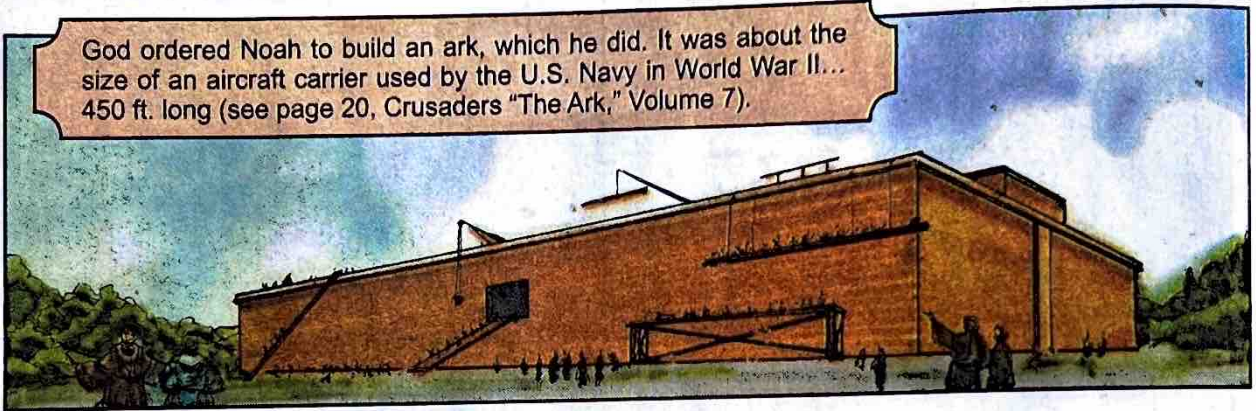


His name was Noah. "...Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God." (Genesis 6:9)

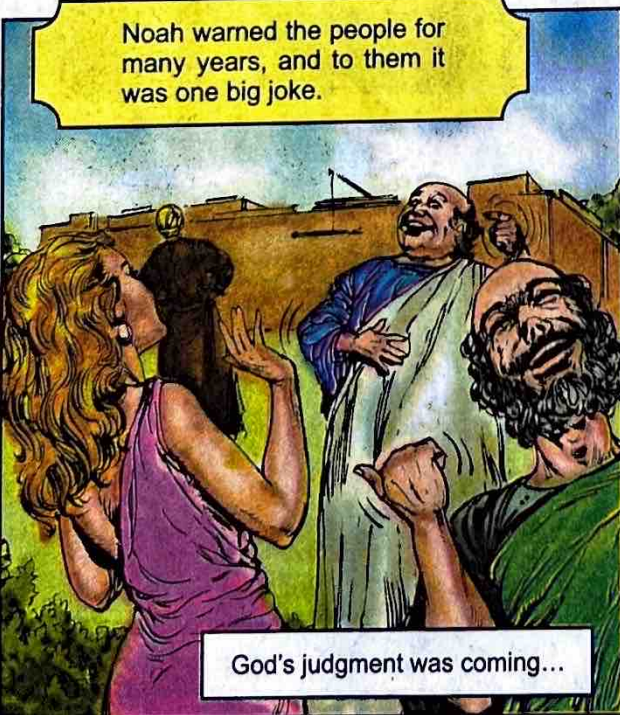
Methuselah was still living... the year he would die would be the year the great flood would come.

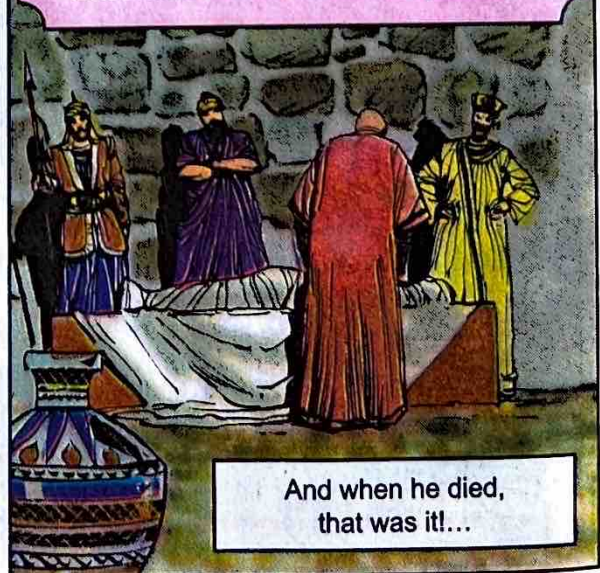


Noah warned the people for many years, and to them it was one big joke.

Noah, his wife and his 3 sons, Ham, Shem and Japheth and their wives...

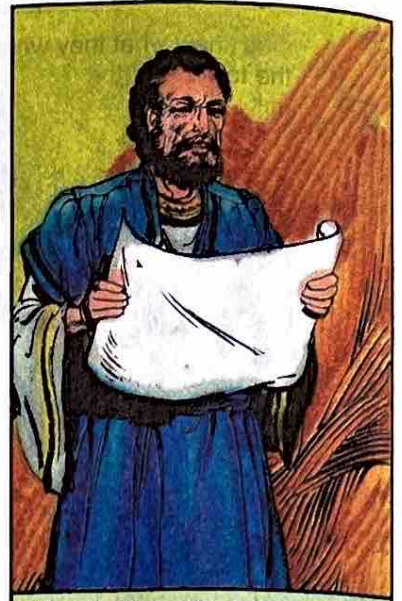


were in the ark with the animals. The ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat\* and the population explosion started up again.

(Genesis 9:24, 25)

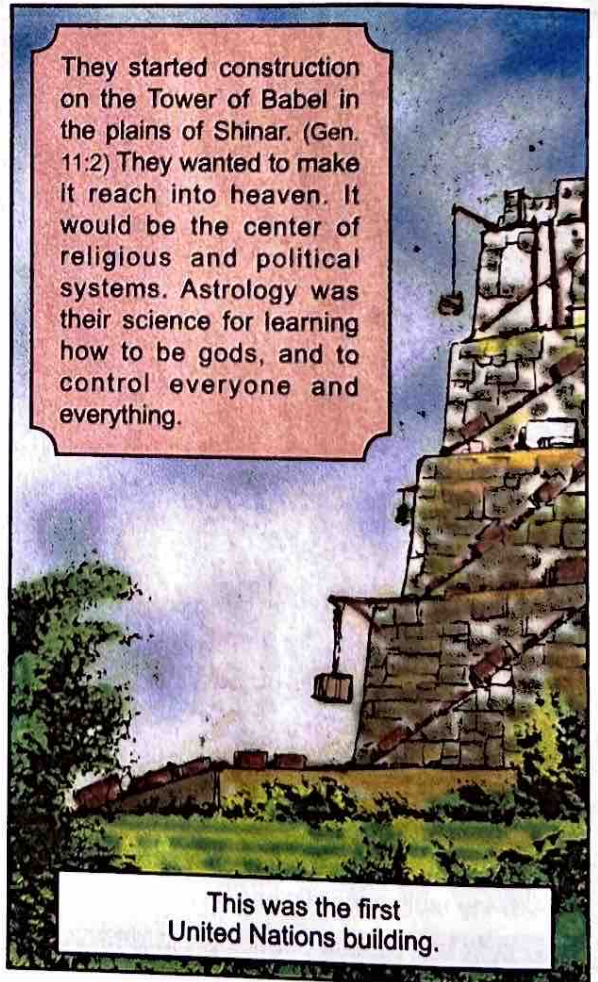


Ham had another son named Cush. He became the big man in politics. He rebelled against God, who commanded the people to fill the earth (Gen. 9:1). Cush brought the people together in one place, settling in the land of Shinar. (See Crusaders Vol. 9, Angel of Light, page 13).

The idea of a one-world government was started way back there just after the flood.



They started construction on the Tower of Babel in the plains of Shinar. (Gen. 11:2) They wanted to make it reach into heaven. It would be the center of religious and political systems. Astrology was their science for learning how to be gods, and to control everyone and everything.



This was the first United Nations building.

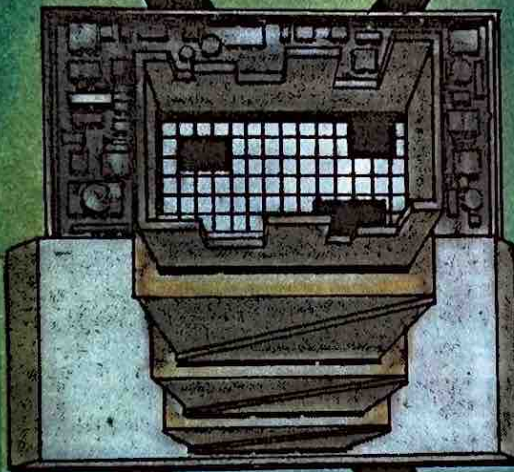

Everyone looked for someone who talked the way they did. When they found someone, they stayed together and eventually took off in different directions.

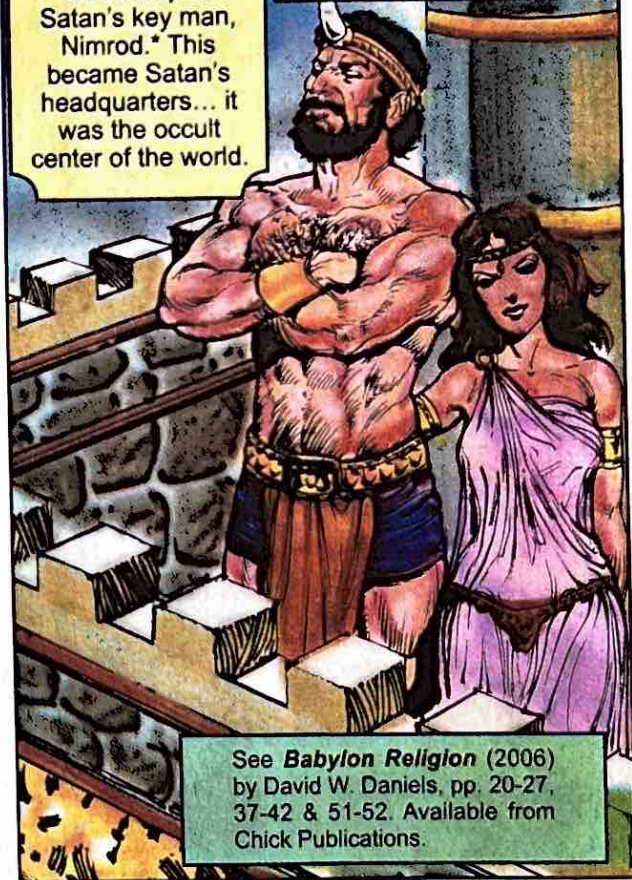


Babylon

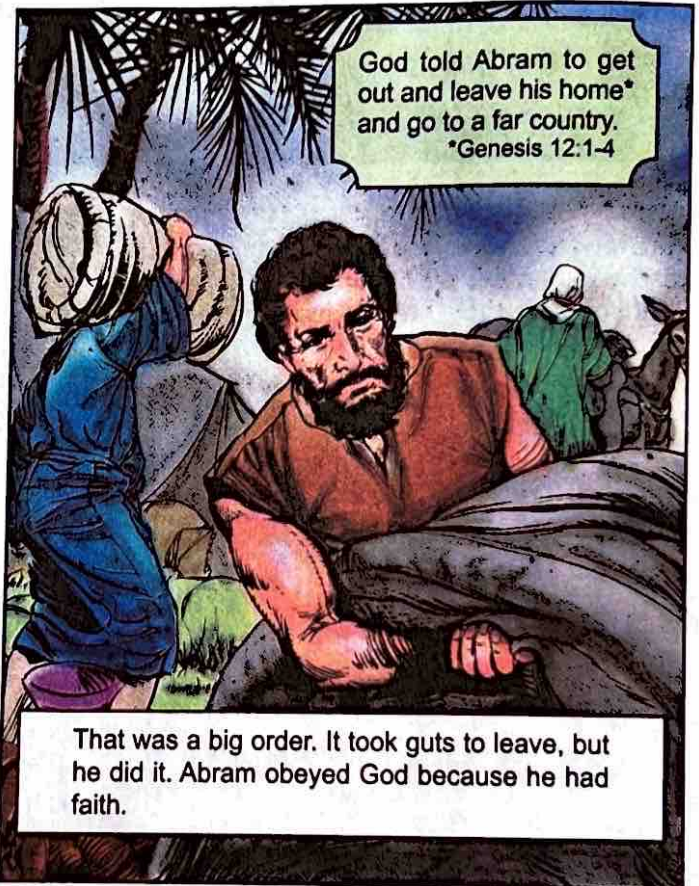
A spiritual darkness covered the world.

could trust...



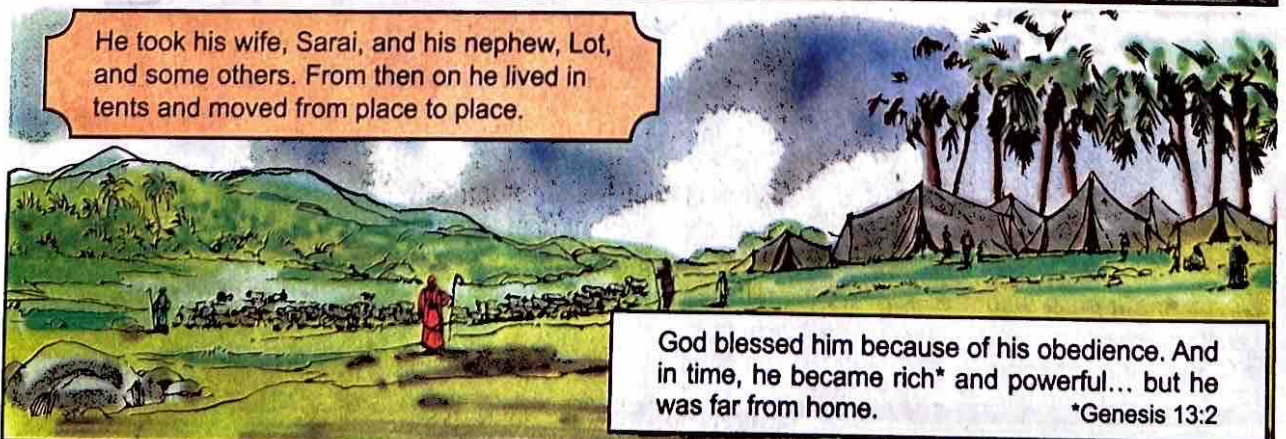
His name was Abram. His home town was a religious mess. Sex was one of their gods. Satan was setting them up for hell.

God told Abram to get out and leave his home\* and go to a far country.  
\*Genesis 12:1-4



That was a big order. It took guts to leave, but he did it. Abram obeyed God because he had faith.

He took his wife, Sarai, and his nephew, Lot, and some others. From then on he lived in tents and moved from place to place.

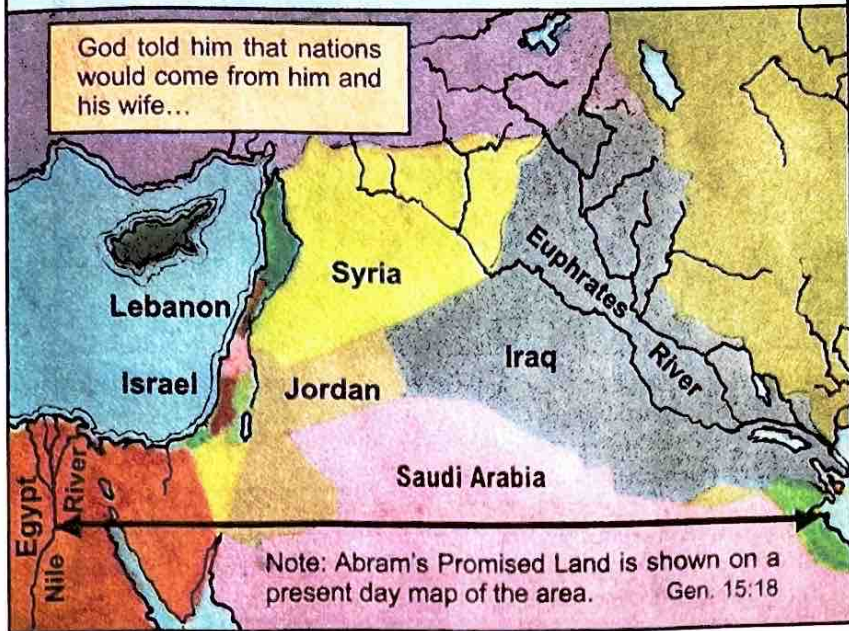


God blessed him because of his obedience. And in time, he became rich\* and powerful... but he was far from home.  
\*Genesis 13:2



God showed Abram all the land He was going to give him and his offspring. It was mind-blowing because he had no children... his wife had a problem. She couldn't have any babies.

God told him that nations would come from him and his wife...



Abram became so wealthy with gold, silver, cattle and sheep that he had a problem with his nephew, Lot. To stop their herdsmen from fighting over the pasture grass and water, they divided company and Lot settled in the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah.



The city of Sodom\* was totally under Satan's control. The people had turned completely away from God. Satan had ordered his demons of homosexuality to take over almost every man, woman, boy and girl, which they did. God cursed that population with minds that couldn't tell the difference between good and evil.\*\* Satan's reward for all those homosexuals was death and damnation for their rebellion against God.

God knew what was going on in the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah. Every act,\* every thought,\*\* and every word\*\*\* they said was being recorded... just like today. Everything was being recorded for the day of judgment.

Lot was upset by their filthy behavior.\* Lot was the only straight person in the entire city. Sodom was doomed. But first, God had to get Lot out of there to protect him.  
\*II Peter 2:7,8

The Lord Jesus\* sent two angels to pull Lot and his family out of the city before blasting it off the face of the earth.



The two angels stayed all night in Lot's house.

\*Judgment is in the hands of Christ.  
(John 5:22)

As soon as it was dark, the streets were filled with those homosexuals demanding that Lot send out the visitors so they could rape them.

The angels blinded the mob, so they finally gave up and went home.



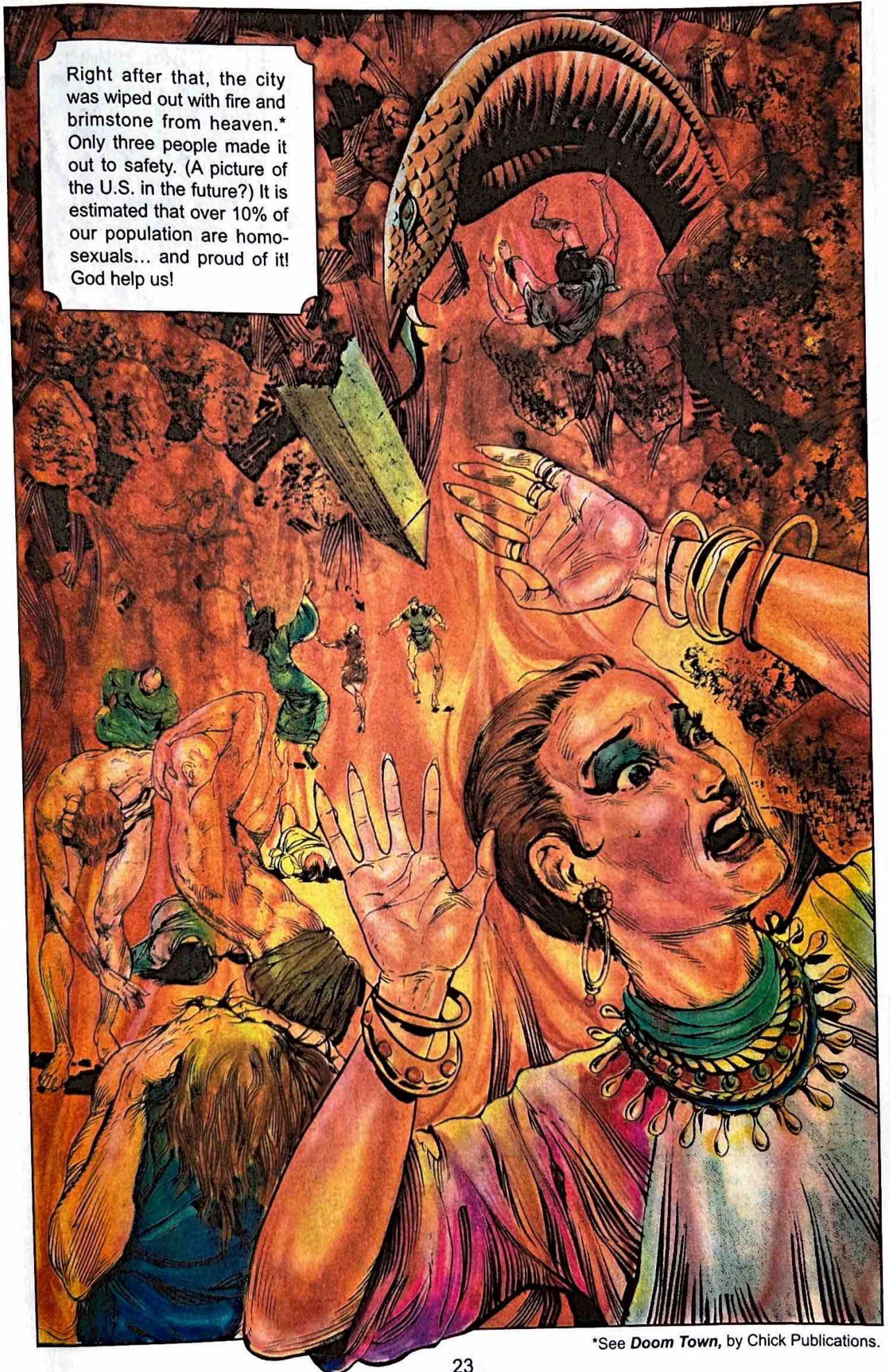
The next morning, Lot, his wife, and two of his daughters were dragged out of the city against their will.

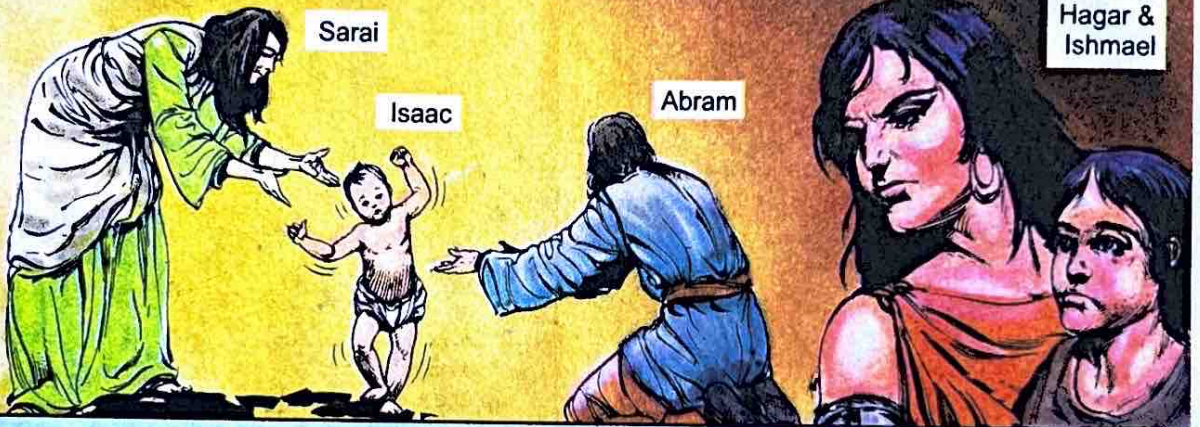


Abram's wife, Sarai, was really upset because the baby that God promised them hadn't come yet... so she came up with an idea to **help God out**. If she was too old to have a baby, her maid could have the baby for her... so she gave her Egyptian maid named Hagar to her husband so Abram and Hagar could produce the baby... and that's what they did. And we are paying for that act of rebellion today.

Hagar gave birth to Ishmael (the father of the Arabs). Little did Sarai know that her act of sin would cause World War III many years later. (But Satan did.)



But the Lord didn't forget His promise... when Abram's wife was 90 years old she conceived and God gave her a baby. It was a miracle! Abram became the proud daddy of a baby boy whom they named Isaac.\*



God then re-named Abram and called him Abraham\*\* and Sarai was re-named Sarah.\*\*\* From those two children, Isaac and Ishmael, came nations and kings, and many wars even until today.

\*\* Abraham means "father of multitudes."

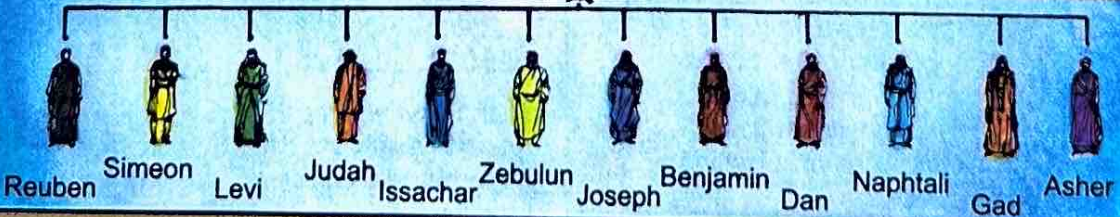
\*\*\* Sarah means "princess."

\*\*"A prince with God." \*\*\*Gen. 49:1-28



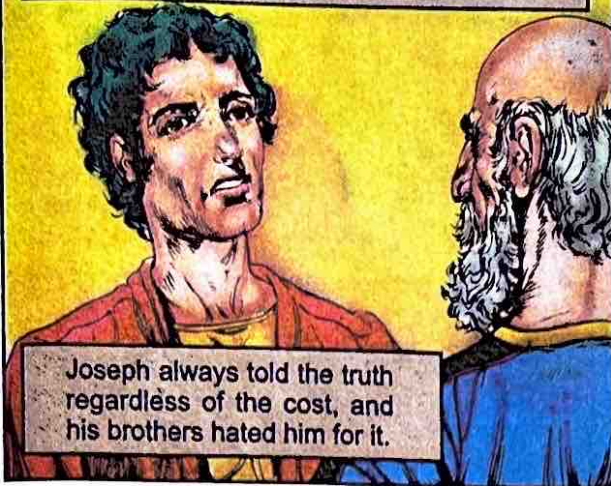

Were they all God-fearing men? No! Only one of them, and his name was Joseph.

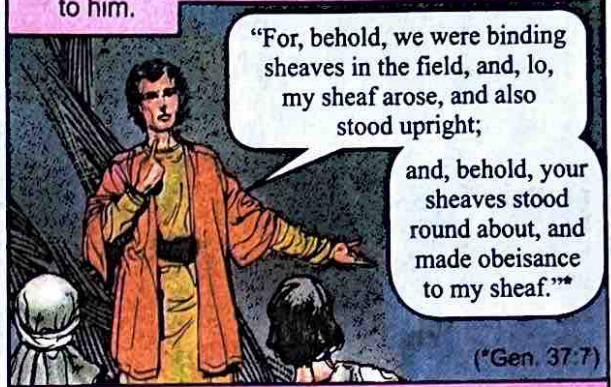


Satan hated Joseph because he was righteous. Joseph obeyed God. His father, Jacob, loved him more than all his brothers.



Joseph always told the truth regardless of the cost, and his brothers hated him for it.

God sent dreams to Joseph telling him that one day his entire family would bow down to him.



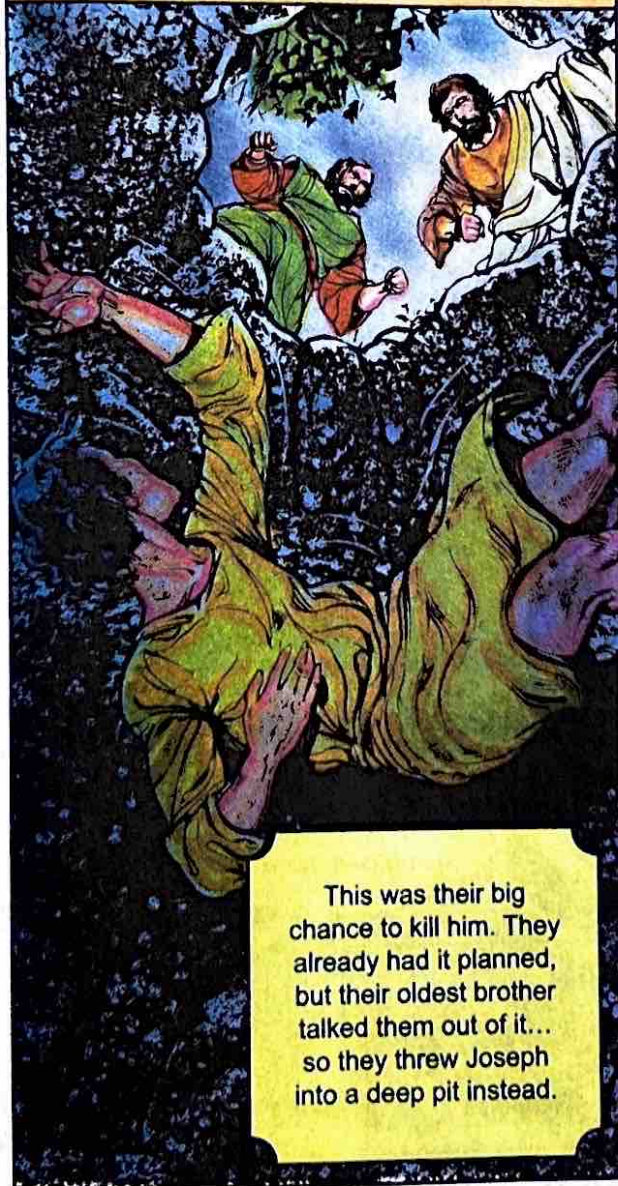
"For, behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright;

and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf."\*

(\*Gen. 37:7)

That **really** made his brothers mad. Who was this little creep that they should bow down to him? He was a trouble-maker. Satan turned their hatred to murder. They wanted Joseph dead.

One day Joseph came alone to his brothers who were out in the fields with their sheep.



This was their big chance to kill him. They already had it planned, but their oldest brother talked them out of it... so they threw Joseph into a deep pit instead.

A caravan was passing by and Joseph's brothers came up with the idea of selling Joseph to the men in the caravan rather than having his blood on their hands.



So his brothers sold him as a slave for 20 pieces of silver.\* They were happy about it... so was Satan. \*Gen. 37:28

Interesting note: Jesus was sold for 30 pieces of silver. Matt. 27:9

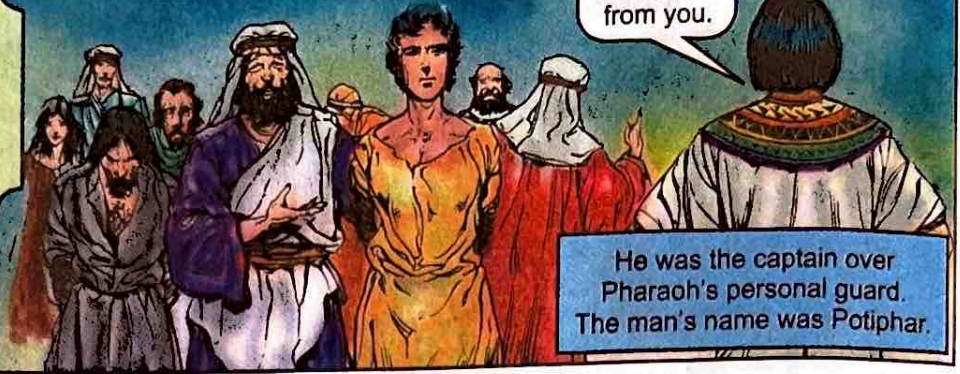
Now they had to lie to their father. They told him that little Joseph was killed by a wild animal. They put blood on his coat and showed it to Jacob.



Their father was heart-broken and wept over his son's death. He was never happy again. It made his brothers feel guilty every day about what they had done to Joseph.



The caravan took Joseph down to Egypt and sold him to a very big man in the Egyptian army.



I'll buy him from you.

He was the captain over Pharaoh's personal guard. The man's name was Potiphar.

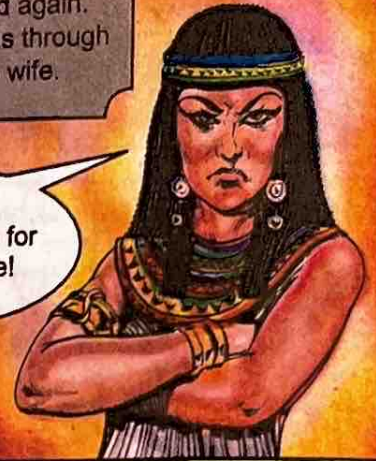
God put Joseph into the house of this Egyptian. Everything Joseph touched made money for his master, both in his house and in his fields.



God blessed Potiphar for Joseph's sake, and Potiphar knew that God was with Joseph. Soon Joseph was running Potiphar's house for him. He had complete trust in Joseph.

Satan moved again. This time it was through Potiphar's wife.

I'll fix Joseph for ignoring me!



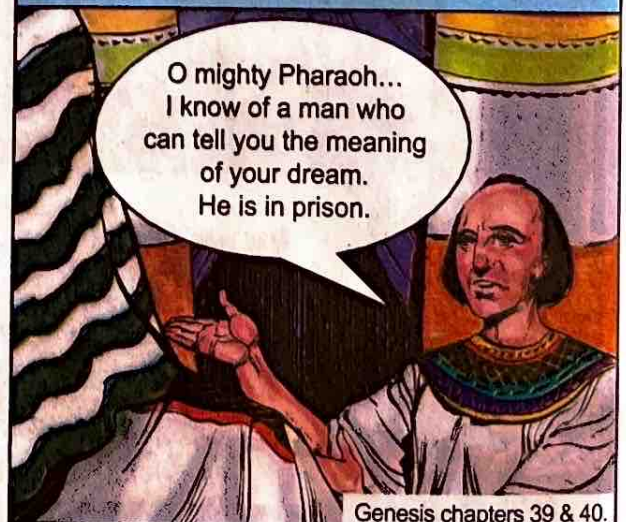
She framed Joseph on a phony rape charge and he went to prison. He was completely innocent. This same technique is being used on God's true servants today.

Two other men were also in prison because they had offended Pharaoh. They were his butler and his baker. They were afraid...



Both had a dream and Joseph told them what their dreams meant: the baker would be put to death and the butler would go back to serving Pharaoh. And it happened just that way.

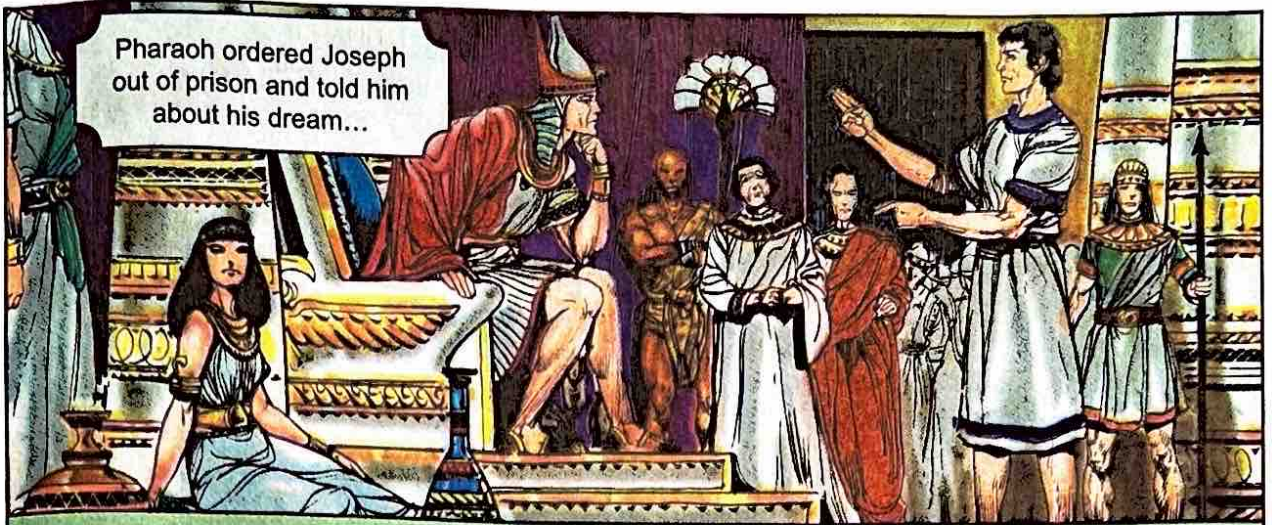
Two years later, Joseph was still in prison and mighty Pharaoh had a mysterious dream that troubled him. No one could tell him what his dream meant. Pharaoh's butler heard about it and remembered that when he was in prison, Joseph had explained his dream to him — and it came true. The butler told Pharaoh about Joseph.



O mighty Pharaoh... I know of a man who can tell you the meaning of your dream. He is in prison.

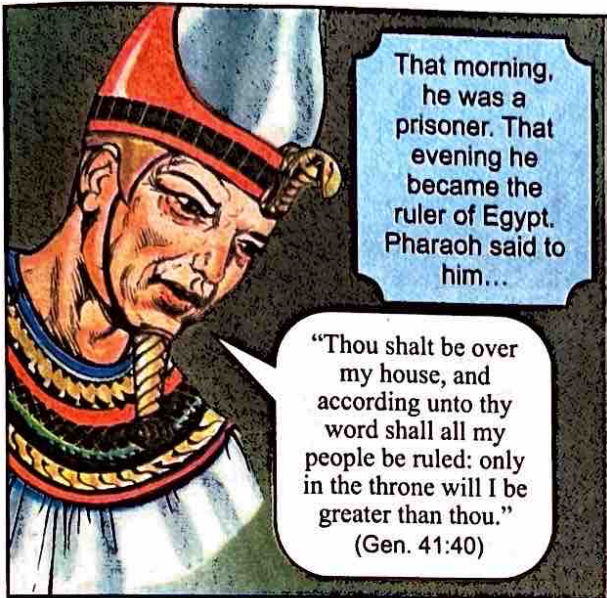
Genesis chapters 39 & 40.





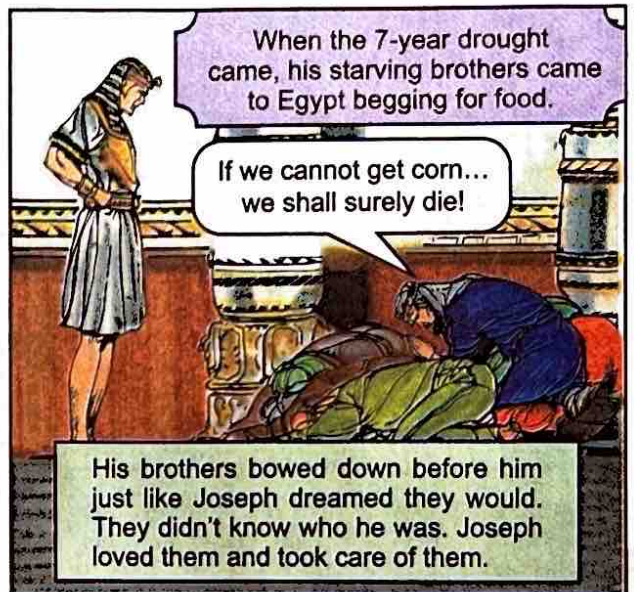
Pharaoh ordered Joseph out of prison and told him about his dream...

Joseph explained that it meant that the world, including Egypt, would be hit by a horrible 7-year drought, but first there would be 7 good years with plenty of corn. He suggested that Pharaoh put someone in charge of storing up the surplus corn so that they could survive the coming drought. Even Pharaoh knew God was with Joseph. He put Joseph in charge of protecting Egypt and its economy.



That morning, he was a prisoner. That evening he became the ruler of Egypt. Pharaoh said to him...

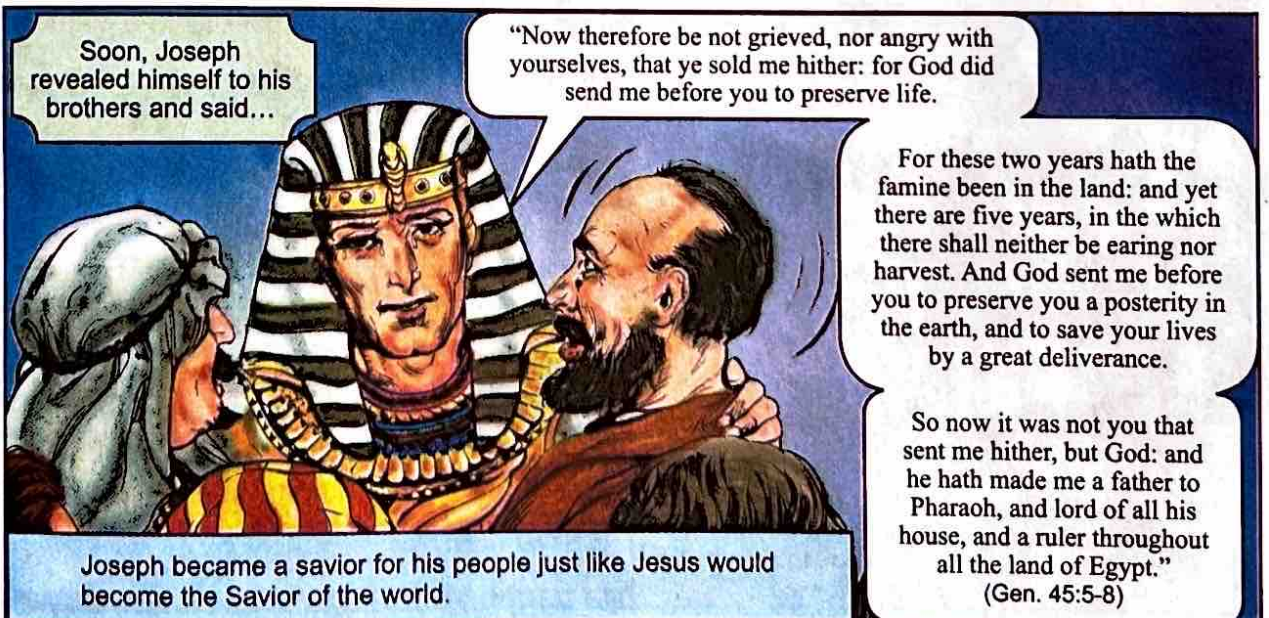
"Thou shalt be over my house, and according unto thy word shall all my people be ruled: only in the throne will I be greater than thou."  
(Gen. 41:40)



When the 7-year drought came, his starving brothers came to Egypt begging for food.

If we cannot get corn... we shall surely die!

His brothers bowed down before him just like Joseph dreamed they would. They didn't know who he was. Joseph loved them and took care of them.



Soon, Joseph revealed himself to his brothers and said...

"Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life.

For these two years hath the famine been in the land: and yet there are five years, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest. And God sent me before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance.

So now it was not you that sent me hither, but God: and he hath made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt."  
(Gen. 45:5-8)

Joseph became a savior for his people just like Jesus would become the Savior of the world.



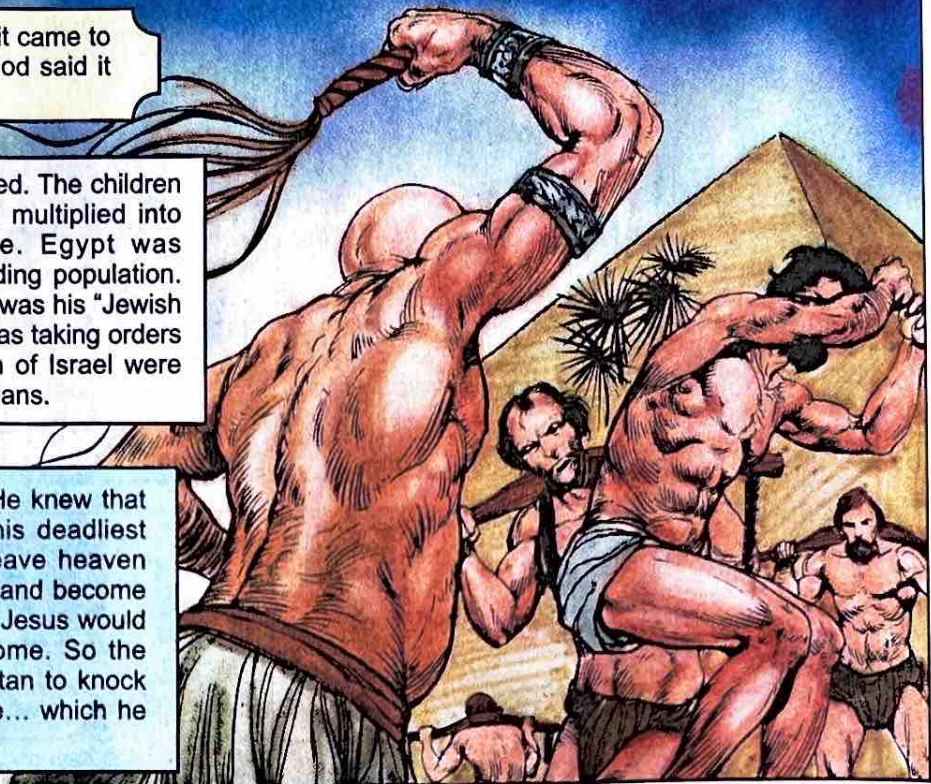
Now let's watch an amazing Bible prophecy be fulfilled.

Remember Abraham? He was Joseph's great-grandfather. (See pages 20-24) The Bible tells us that God gave Abraham a vision (a prophecy) that said: "...Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years." (Genesis 15:13)

(Now we will see how it came to pass just exactly as God said it would.)

Joseph had long since died. The children of Israel (the Jews) had multiplied into about 3 million people. Egypt was worried about this exploding population. To the new Pharaoh, this was his "Jewish problem," and Pharaoh was taking orders from Satan. The children of Israel were made slaves of the Egyptians.

Satan was no dummy. He knew that at some point in time his deadliest enemy, Jesus, would leave heaven and come to this planet and become a man. Satan knew that Jesus would be born in a Jewish home. So the only answer was for Satan to knock off the entire Israeli race... which he tried to do in Egypt.

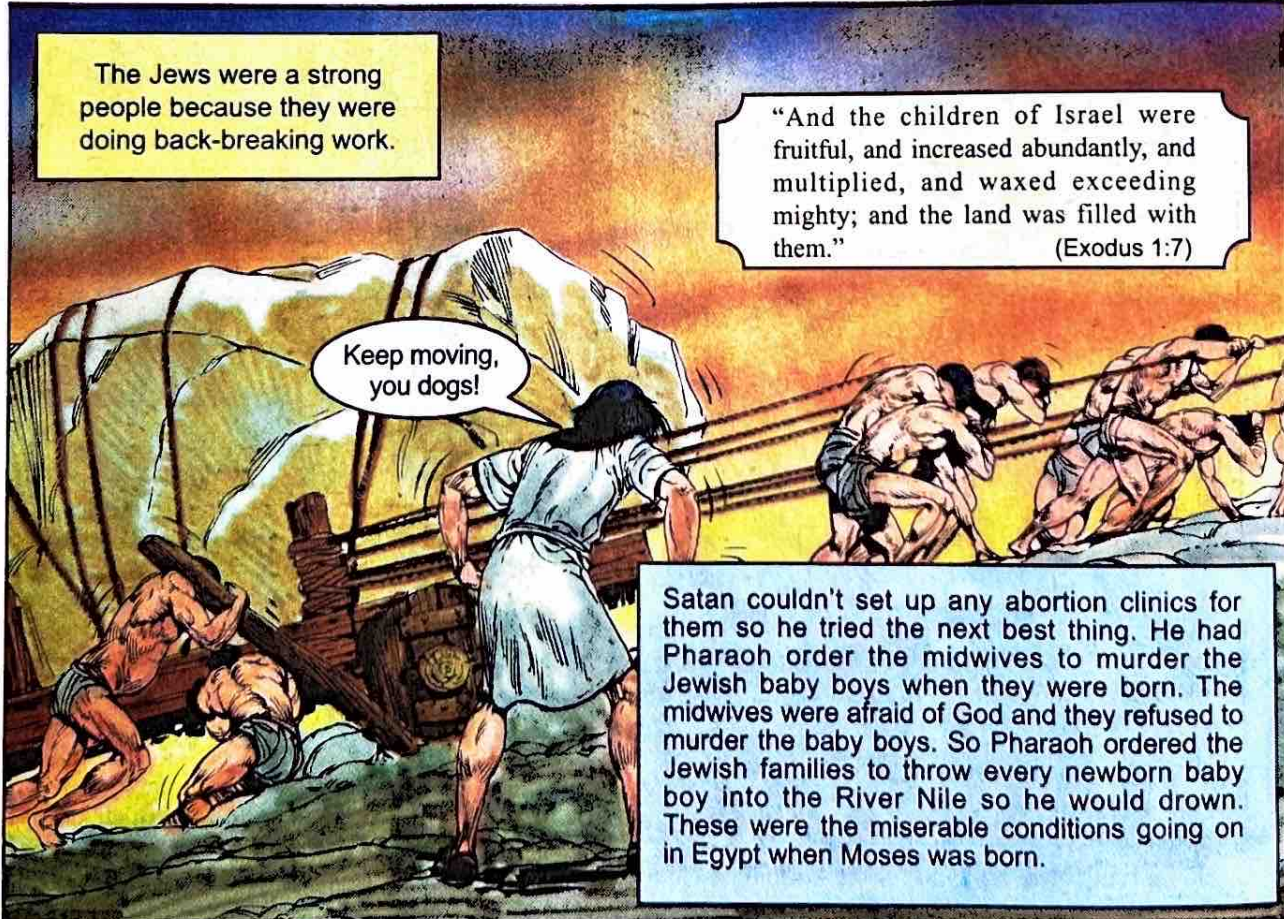


The Jews were a strong people because they were doing back-breaking work.

"And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty; and the land was filled with them." (Exodus 1:7)

Keep moving, you dogs!

Satan couldn't set up any abortion clinics for them so he tried the next best thing. He had Pharaoh order the midwives to murder the Jewish baby boys when they were born. The midwives were afraid of God and they refused to murder the baby boys. So Pharaoh ordered the Jewish families to throw every newborn baby boy into the River Nile so he would drown. These were the miserable conditions going on in Egypt when Moses was born.



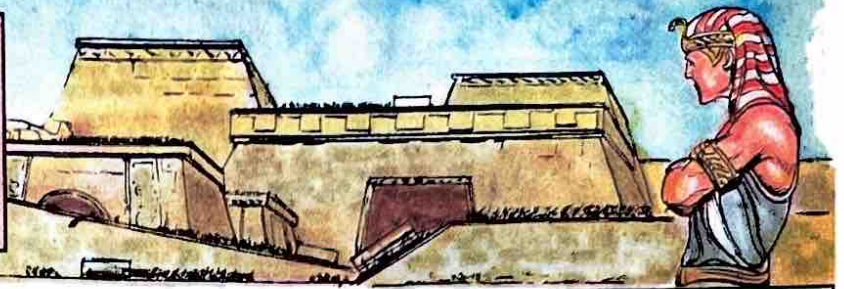


When Moses was a baby, his mother put him in a little ark (or basket) covered with tar and hid him in the Nile River among the water plants... Exodus 2:3



Little Moses was found by Pharaoh's daughter and she raised him as her own son... he got the best teachers in the world.

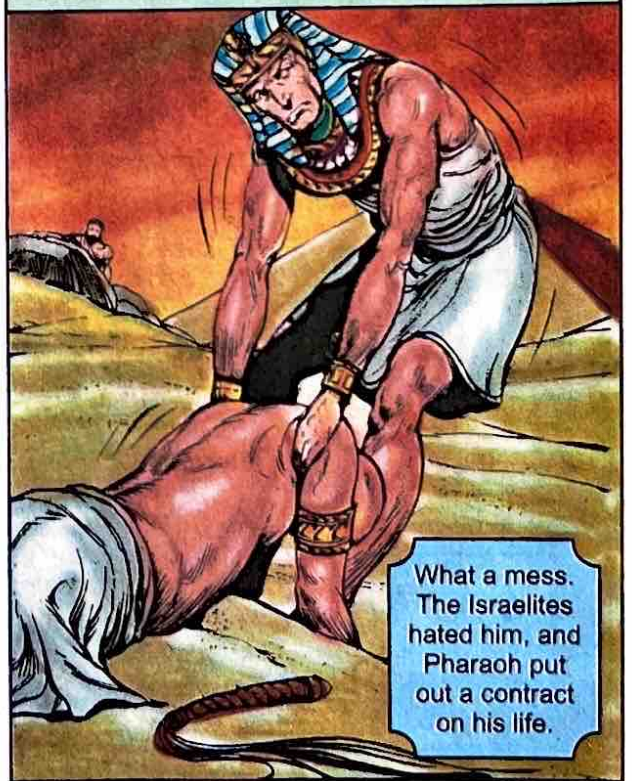
Moses grew up to be a big wheel in Egyptian politics. He was a member of Pharaoh's family. He was in charge of building cities using Jewish slaves.



Moses couldn't stand the way the Jews were being treated like dogs. He knew he was also a Jew.



Moses felt called of God to deliver his people from this oppression. His mistake was in trying to do it himself, instead of with God's guidance. In anger, Moses killed an Egyptian for beating an Israeli.\* He hid the body in the sand, but he was being watched. Word got out, and Moses had to run for his life.\*\*

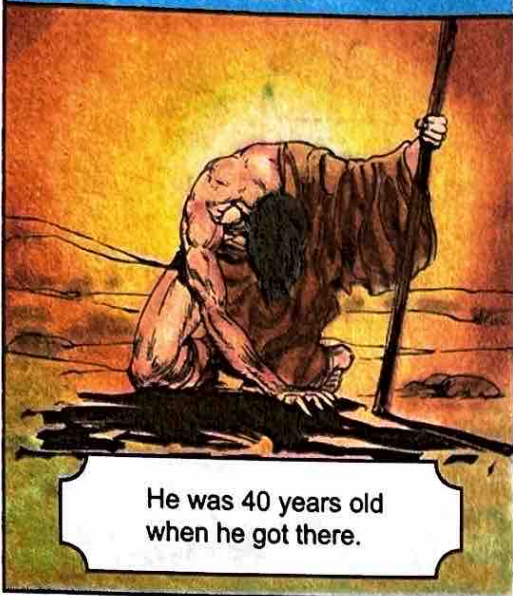


What a mess. The Israelites hated him, and Pharaoh put out a contract on his life.

Moses crossed a burning desert and traveled alone for about 800 miles to a place called Midian.



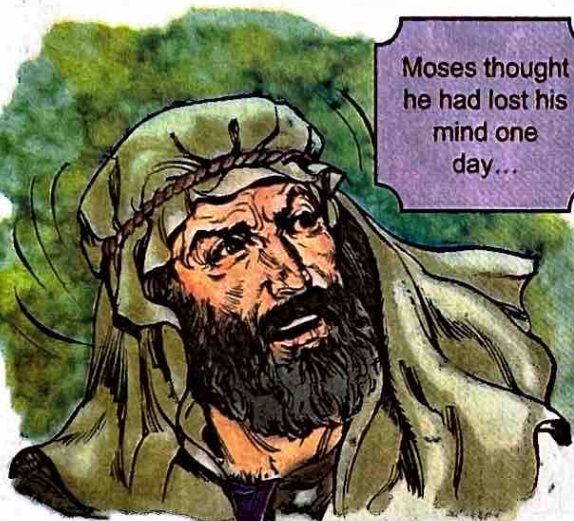
He was 40 years old when he got there.

God kept Moses there for 40 more years... it was a hard time for Moses. God showed him that his college degree from the Egyptian schools was worthless. God would now re-train Moses.

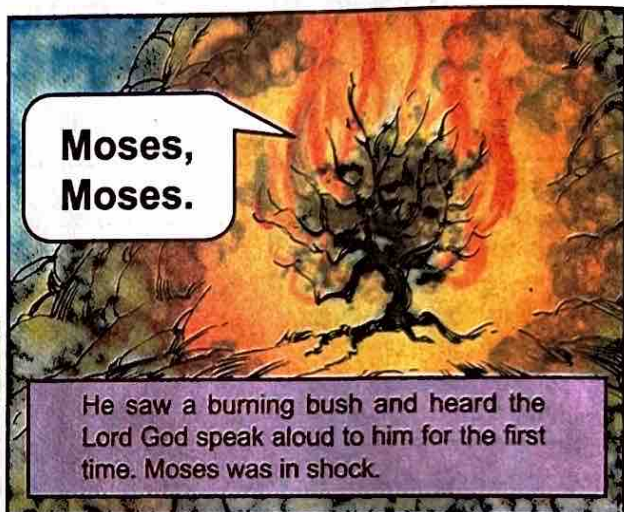


In Egypt it was a no-no for any Egyptian to be a shepherd... Moses ended up taking care of a flock of sheep for his father-in-law. God broke him. Only now could the Lord Jesus use him.

Moses thought he had lost his mind one day...

He saw a burning bush and heard the Lord God speak aloud to him for the first time. Moses was in shock.

The Lord wanted him to go back to Egypt and lead those Jewish slaves to freedom and out of Egypt, now that he was ready to do it God's way. The Lord wanted Moses to lead the Israelites into the land He'd given to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob as an inheritance forever.

This is what you shall say: "I AM" has sent me to you.

Who should I say sent me to lead them out of Egypt?

That, my friends, is one of the titles\*\* of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Moses went back to Egypt... and nobody wanted him. The Jews didn't trust him and Pharaoh hated him. He told Pharaoh that the Lord God wanted the Israelites to leave Egypt. Pharaoh thought Moses was crazy.

"Who is the Lord, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the Lord, neither will I let Israel go." (Exodus 5:2)

So God sent 10 plagues upon Egypt, one at a time, until Pharaoh gave up and let the Jews go with Moses. The plagues destroyed Egypt as a world power.

Remember the evil religious system set up back in Babylon? (See page 20) Well, it was doing very well in Egypt under different names, all controlled by Satan.



These are some of the gods of Egypt:

- People were sacrificed to crocodiles in the Nile River – turning the water red with blood..
- Flies, frogs, locusts and cattle were worshiped as gods.\*
- There was Serapis, a goddess they prayed to when they had boils.
- There was a goddess of the sky called Nut. Also the goddess, Isis, was involved with Seth, another god in protecting the crops.
- The sun god, Horus, gave them light.

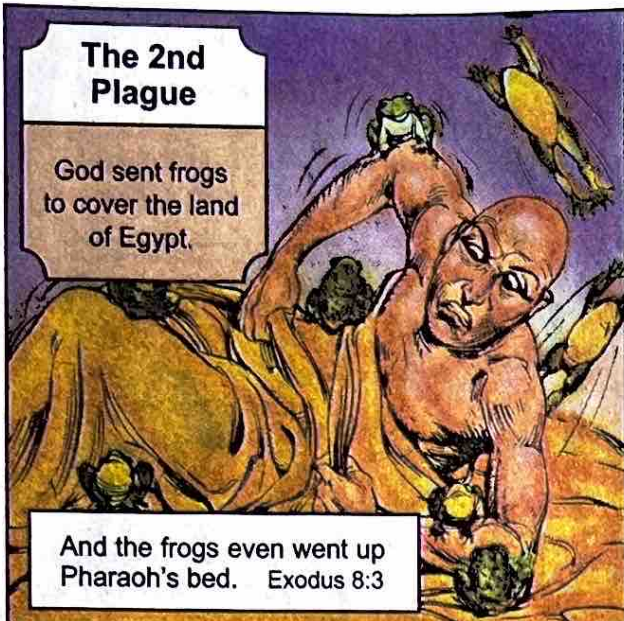




## The 2nd Plague

Pharaoh promised Moses that he would let Israel go, if Moses got rid of the frogs.



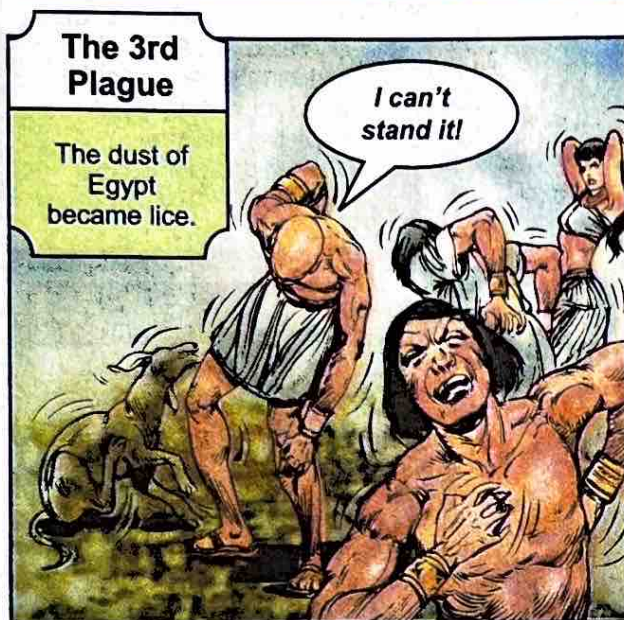
The frogs died... they were gathered in heaps and the land stank – and Pharaoh refused to let the children go, his heart was hardened.

## The 3rd Plague

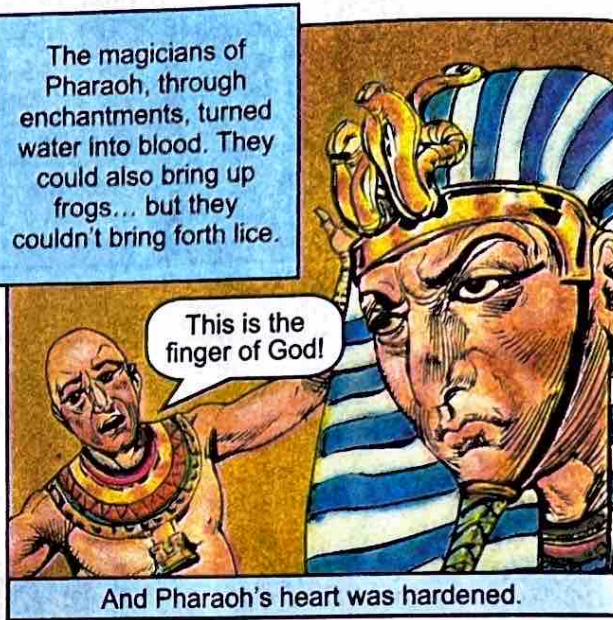
The dust of Egypt became lice.

This is the finger of God!

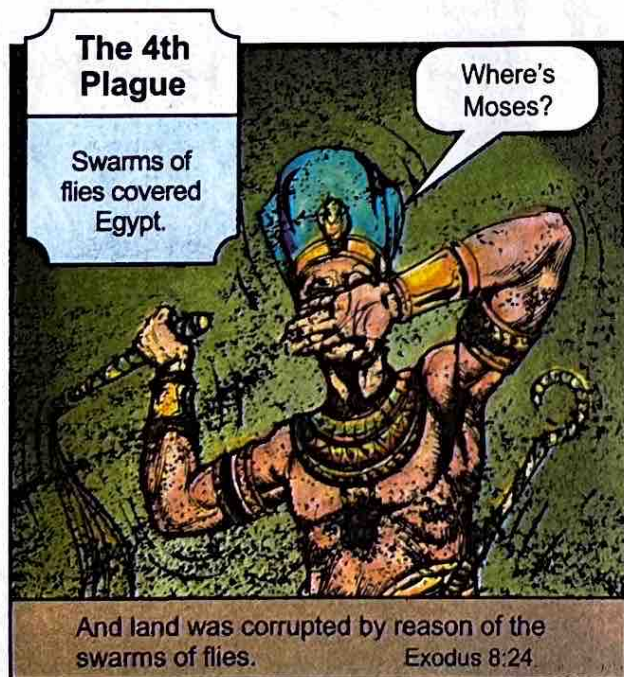


And Pharaoh's heart was hardened.

## The 4th Plague

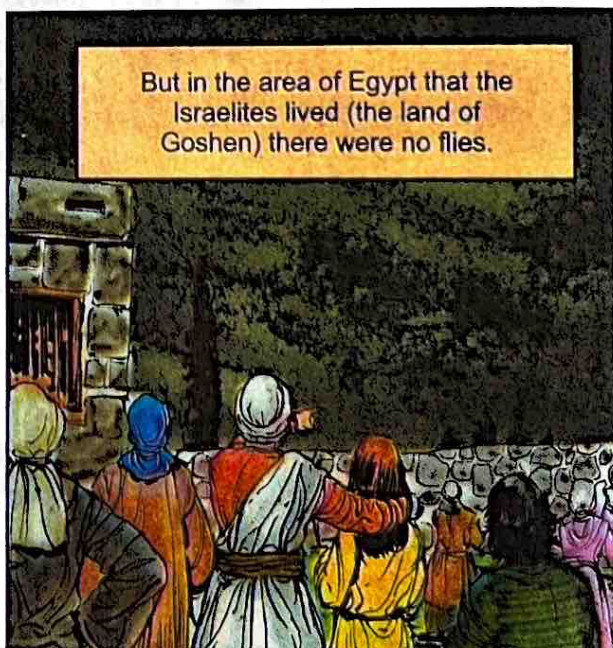
Swarms of flies covered Egypt.

But in the area of Egypt that the Israelites lived (the land of Goshen) there were no flies.



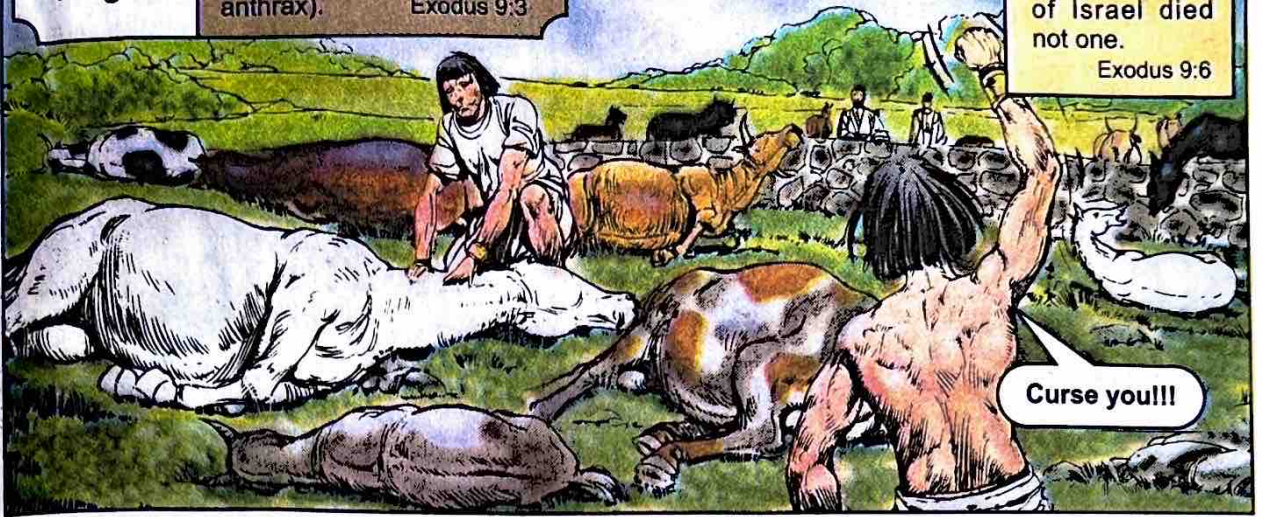


### The 5th Plague

And all the cattle died.

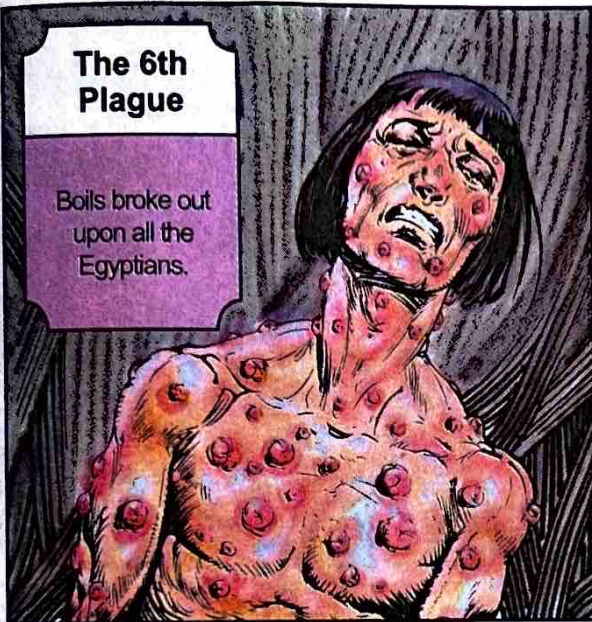
But of the cattle of the children of Israel died not one. Exodus 9:6

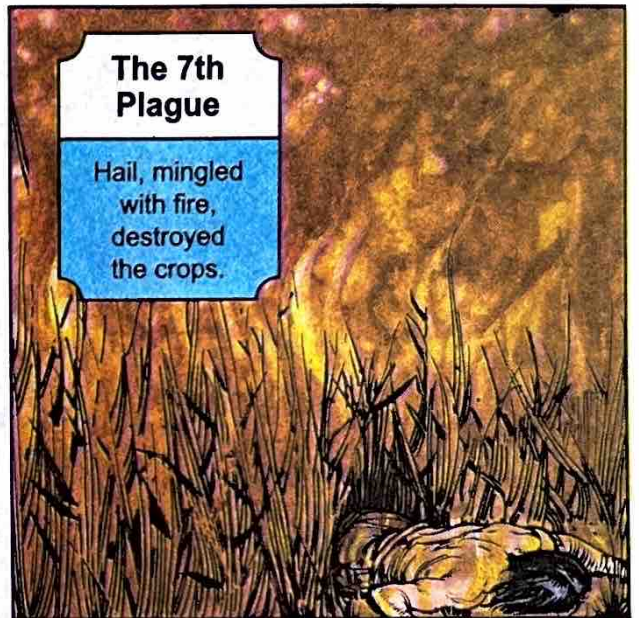
### The 6th Plague

### The 7th Plague

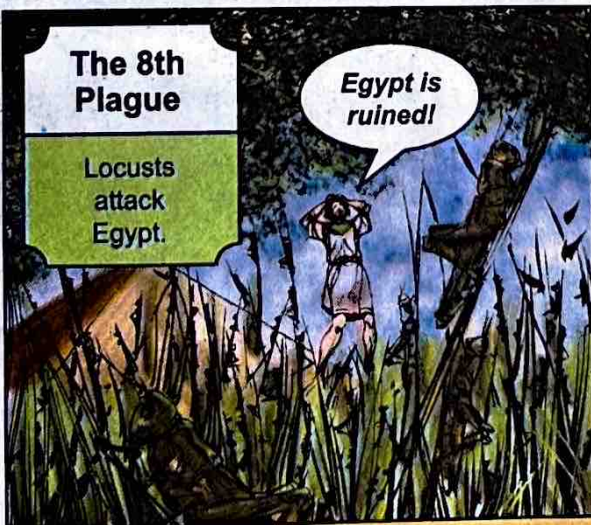
Hail, mingled with fire, destroyed the crops.

Darkness over the land: for 3 days and 3 nights, darkness that could be felt.

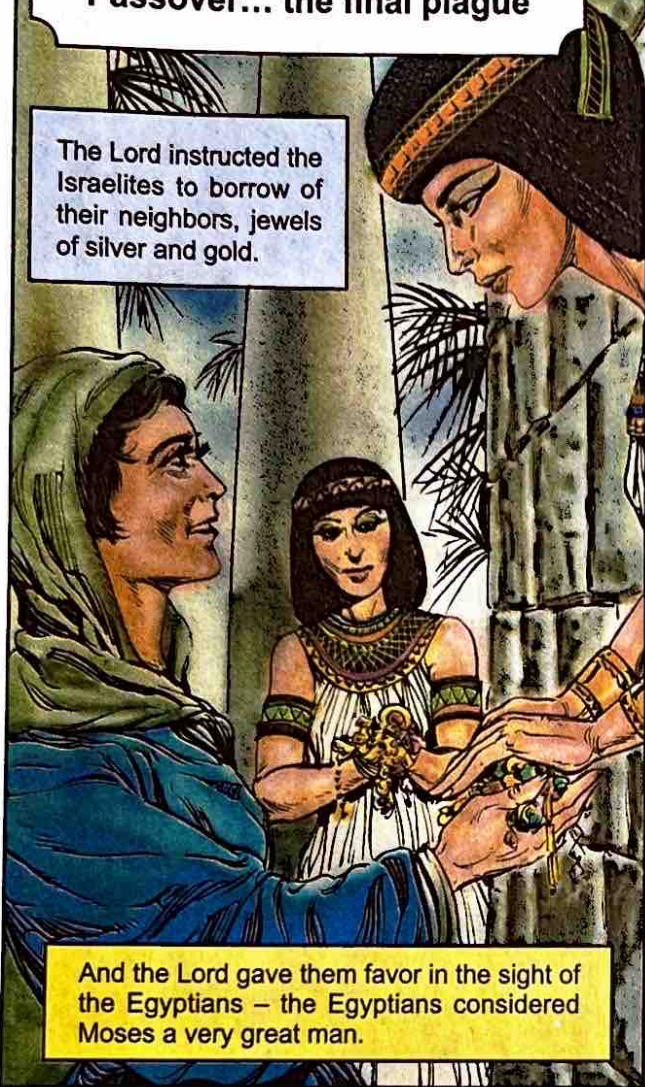
Moses... go get Moses!

Later Pharaoh again refused to let the children of Israel go.



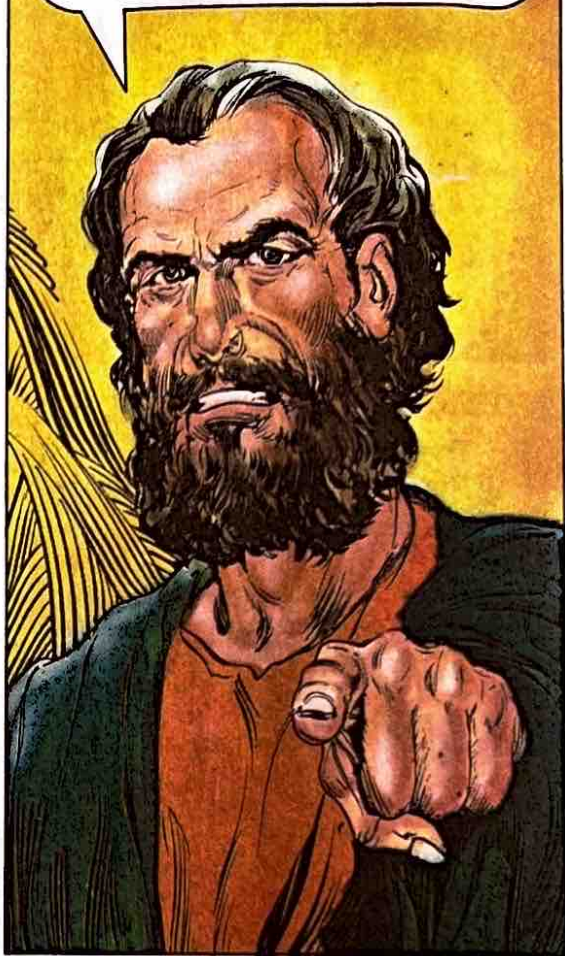
## Preparation for the Passover... the final plague

The Lord instructed the Israelites to borrow of their neighbors, jewels of silver and gold.



And the Lord gave them favor in the sight of the Egyptians – the Egyptians considered Moses a very great man.

“... Thus saith the Lord, About midnight will I go out into the midst of Egypt: And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.” (Exodus 11:4-5)



Every Jewish house shall take a lamb without blemish...



and shall kill it – it shall be the Passover lamb.

The blood of the lamb is put into a basin – and a bunch of hyssop was dipped into the blood.



Then the hyssop was struck against the lintel and the two sideposts of the door leaving the blood on them.



“And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.” Exodus 12:13



The Lord Jesus Christ was ready to smash Egypt. He saw the lamb sacrificed for the Passover. He looked into the future when He Himself, the Creator of the universe, would become the sacrifice for the sins of the world. I John 2:2

That night the families joined together in their homes and ate the roasted lamb, the unleavened bread and bitter herbs, as the Lord had directed.



They were frightened. They made sure the blood was on their doors\* so that they would escape the awful coming judgment.

\*Exodus 12:7, 23

Screams were heard throughout that night as the Lord Jesus\* passed through Egypt. The firstborn in every Egyptian home died. It was a nightmare. Even the firstborn of all the cattle were hit. The Egyptians were terrified.

O great goddess Isis, help us...

Nooo! He's dead!

Nooo!...

When the Lord Jesus saw a house, He looked for the blood on the front door... if He saw the blood, He passed over the house and the firstborn was allowed to live...this is why it is called "Passover."



The palace of Pharaoh was hit... the destroying angel killed Pharaoh's only son who was the main god of the Egyptian people. What a blow to Egypt. The Lord had wiped out the *only* heir to the throne.

Mighty Pharaoh, if you don't send them away right now, we will all die.

Send for Moses!



In the middle of the night, Moses comes to the palace.

"...get you forth from among my people, both ye and the children of Israel; and go, serve the Lord, as ye have said."\*



\*Exodus 12:31

Under orders from Pharaoh, the children of Israel departed from Egypt after serving them for 400 years... thus fulfilling the prophecy God gave Abraham.\*

\*See Genesis 15:13

Get out!


It's time to go!

Where's mama?



"It is a night to be much observed unto the LORD for bringing them out from the land of Egypt: this is that night of the LORD to be observed of all the children of Israel in their generations." (Exodus 12:42)






Moses led the children of Israel out of Egypt... around 3 million people and their animals.

Pharaoh was boiling mad. He hated Moses as much as the devil did.

Satan directed Pharaoh to change his mind again and send his army against the Israelites to destroy them all in the wilderness.




The Israelites were blocked by the Red Sea and they could see the Egyptian army coming for the kill. The mob screamed at Moses that he had brought them out to have them slaughtered by Pharaoh's army. Three million complaining Israelites, all accusing, and now hating Moses. What a mess for Moses! Only God Almighty could save them now.

Then God Almighty, the Lord Jesus, appeared as a pillar of fire between the Egyptians and the children of Israel... Pharaoh couldn't get to them. The Israelites were terrified. In faith, believing God... Moses stood by the sea. He lifted up his rod and stretched forth his hand and ordered the Israelites to stand still and watch the salvation of the Lord... and immediately the Lord sent a mighty east wind. It blew all night long, and made the sea dry land.\*

\*See Exodus 14:21





God worked a mighty miracle and the Red Sea was divided. This was their only chance for escape. Behind them was Pharaoh's bloodthirsty army. The Israelites were scared to death. Before them were two gigantic walls of water and dry ground.

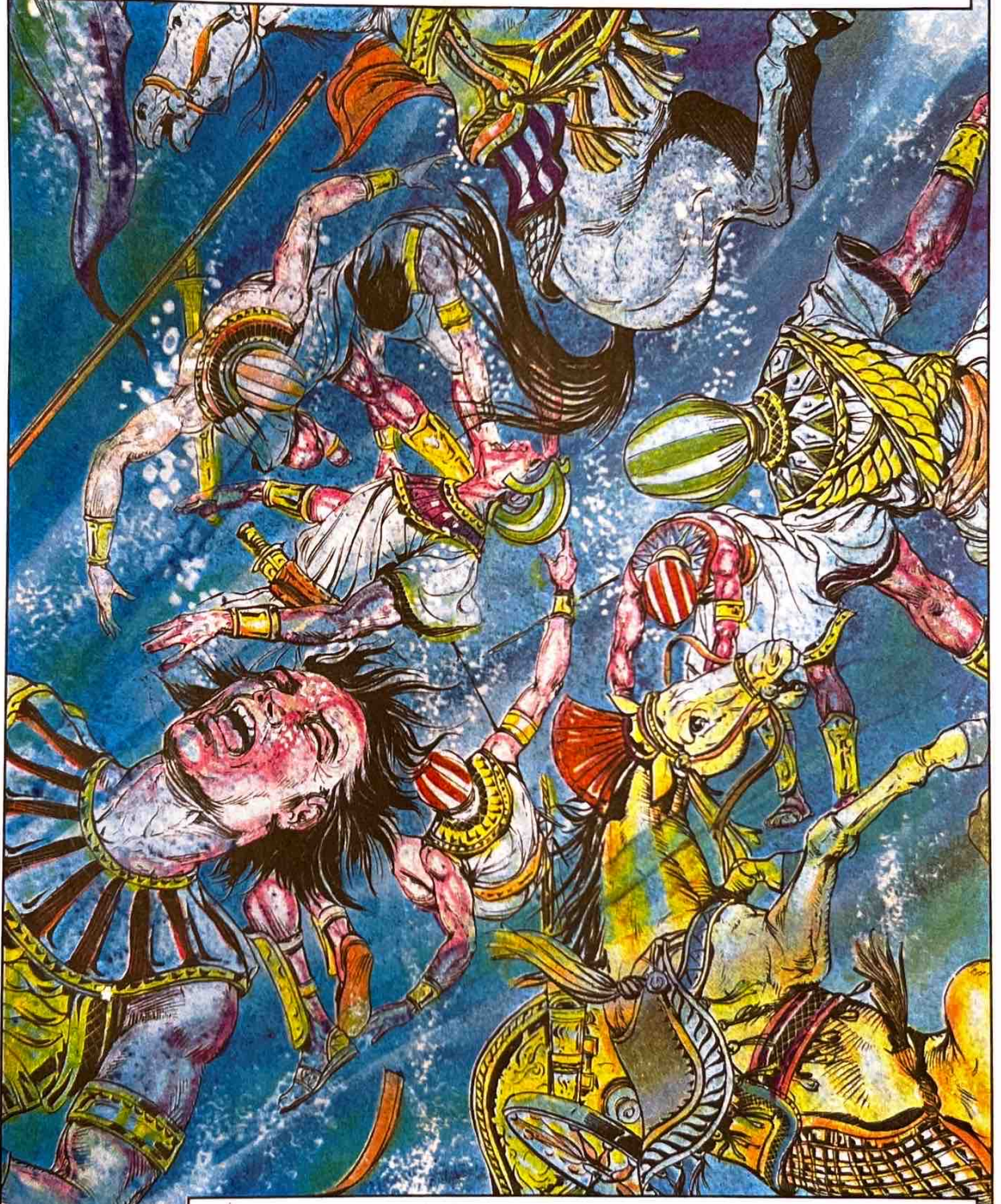
**Note:** For 3 million Israelites to cross over the Red Sea in **one night\*** would require an opening large enough for 5,000 abreast to pass through. \*Exodus 14

Would God hold back the water long enough for them to get through? It took guts and faith. They prayed the water wouldn't crash in on them!...

God kept the pillar of fire and smoke between the Israelis and the Egyptians to confuse the Egyptians and hold them back until the last Israeli was safely on the other side.



Now was the time for God's awful judgment on Pharaoh and his army. God moved the pillar. They drove like mad into the valley in the water, trying to catch the Israelites. The chariot wheels snapped — horses fell. The entire army was bogged down between two great walls of water and then... the Lord Jesus commanded the waters to close. They did, and Egypt lost its king and its army in the churning sea.



Egypt was destroyed. The crops were gone, the economy was bankrupt because they had given the Israelites most of their gold and silver. All the firstborn were dead, (including their flocks and herds) and all the mighty men of Egypt were gone. The government no longer existed. It was total disaster for Egypt. It never recovered.



**The wilderness journey**

God had called His chosen people out of Egypt... they were to be a light to the world. Remember, the whole world was in spiritual darkness except for the Israelites. The evil religious system set up by Nimrod back in Babylon was now world-wide. Every nation or tribe on earth was into a form of devil worship as their organized religion. (Just like today.)



Religion is Satan's business, and more people will go to hell through religion than any other means. Now let's watch how God's people would act before the world as the Lord's ambassadors.

We were better off as slaves.

We're going to die out here! It's an evil plot by Moses.

I tell you, Moses is crazy... how are we going to feed our families out here?

At least we had water in Egypt.

I wish I was back home... I hate this place!

Moses was now stuck with about 3 million rebellious, complaining, stiff-necked Israelites in a hot, barren desert with no food or water.



The Lord loved them\* and supplied them with water and sent them food from heaven called "manna"\*\*\* for 40 years.  
\*Ex. 34:6, 7 \*\* Ex. 16:4, 5

It was like a little cookie that tasted like honey. It was a perfect food that kept them healthy... there was no disease in the camp.

Note: The total amount of food for 3 million people for 40 years was about 58,400,000,000 tons. The amount of water was over 160 billion gallons. (That's level)

They sat in their tents and wished they were back in Egypt. They soon got sick of Moses and the manna from heaven.

I hate this way of living.

Who does Moses think he is, anyway?

The Lord was a cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night to protect them. When the cloud moved, they folded up their tents and followed. Their destination was the Holy Land... God was training them to obey Him and they wanted no part of it.

Poor Moses was worn out. He listened to their complaints all day every day.

Moses, this can not go on this way.

My neighbor stole my coat... and their dog bit my son.

That a lie! She stole my bracelet. It was gold.

Shut up... my son can show Moses the bite.

His father-in-law\* told Moses to use good men to help him out and bring order out of chaos, which he did.  
\*Ex. 18:13-27

All the nations knew about the children of Israel being in the desert with their God, and what the Lord had done to Egypt.

If those Jews and their God attack us, we are dead!

Our armies would be useless against them.

They lived in dread of the Israelites.



On Mt. Sinai, God gave Moses commandments for the people of Israel to follow. He wanted a holy and God-fearing people who would obey Him.

Thou shalt have no other gods before me!  
Thou shalt not steal.  
See Exodus 20:3-17.

Moses spent 40 nights and days with God up in the mountain, and then the Lord gave Moses laws for the children of Israel to protect them... laws on how to live, what to eat, how to keep clean, how to sacrifice, and what was evil in the sight of the Lord. He warned them not to inter-marry with other people or they would become corrupted both physically and spiritually. While Moses was up there, the children of Israel started worshipping one of the god's of Egypt.

Satan was controlling the mob. It turned into one big orgy\* like Sodom and Gomorrah... they forgot about God.

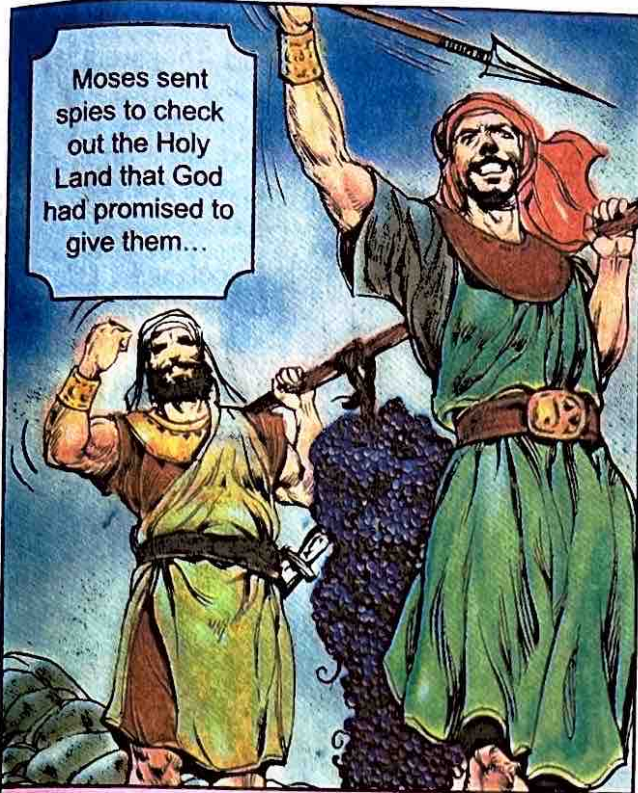
\*A wild sex party.



Moses came off the mountain and was outraged at their rebellion. The Lord was fed up with the people. He was ready to destroy Israel, but Moses begged God not to kill them, and God held back His anger.



Moses sent spies to check out the Holy Land that God had promised to give them...



Two of the spies returned carrying enormous bunches of grapes, saying it was a land of milk and honey. Their names were Joshua and Caleb.

They wanted to obey God and take the land right away.\* The other spies came back saying it was hopeless... the enemies were giants. The Israelites became terrified and refused to go. \*Numbers 14:6-9

What are we going to do?

What a mess... I knew Moses lied to us. I hate him!

We should kill Joshua and Caleb.

They started yelling at Moses again.

The Lord was angry because the people refused to go in and take the land. He said that none of that generation would go into the Promised Land except those two men who were obedient to God: Joshua and Caleb.\* Because of their unbelief, God never allowed the others to leave the desert. \*Numbers 14:29, 30

God doesn't understand that we are weak — that's why we sin.

Grandma... read my palm and tell me who I'm going to marry.

If God is so merciful... why do we have to go through all this?

Shut up... don't you see I'm praying to God?... you fool!

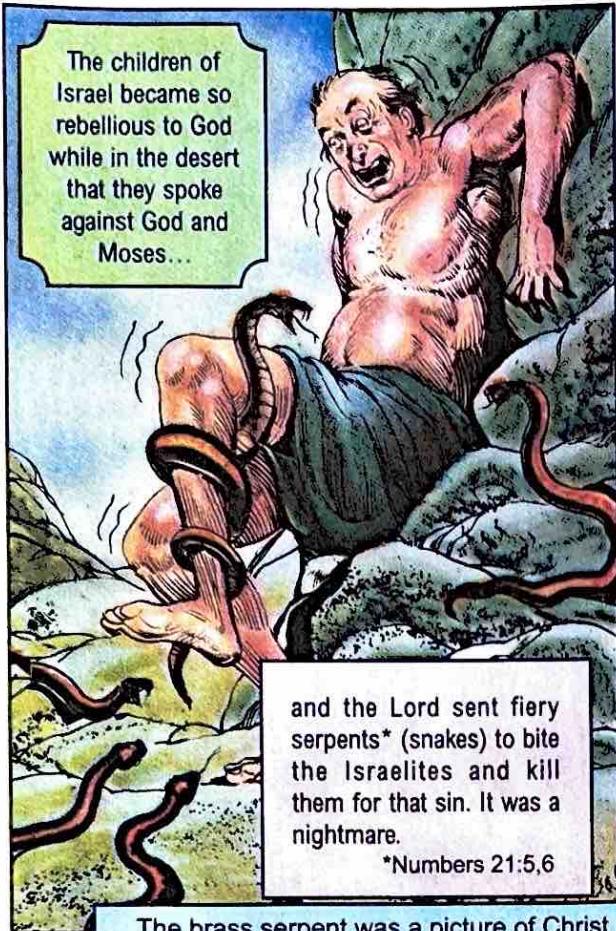
Note: We have seen a picture of God's people in the Old Testament, but they were also a snapshot of God's people today. I am not talking about unbelieving rebellious people who don't believe the Bible, or so-called Christian churches like Rome.\* But Bible-believing, saved, born-again believers in Christ who are sending people to hell just by the hypocritical, two-faced way they are living. We are as bad a witness to the world today, as the rebellious Jews were in the desert... there is *no* difference. Very seldom do you see a Christian who will obey God and be sold out to Christ. God forgive us! We will stand before Christ to give an answer for the rebellious way we've lived.\*\*

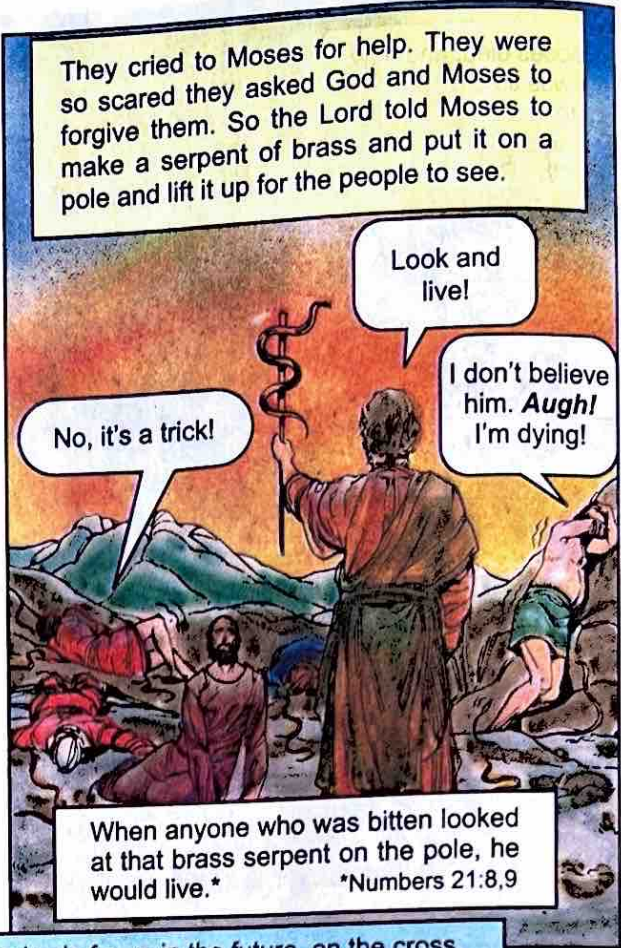

The children of Israel became so rebellious to God while in the desert that they spoke against God and Moses...

and the Lord sent fiery serpents\* (snakes) to bite the Israelites and kill them for that sin. It was a nightmare.  
\*Numbers 21:5,6



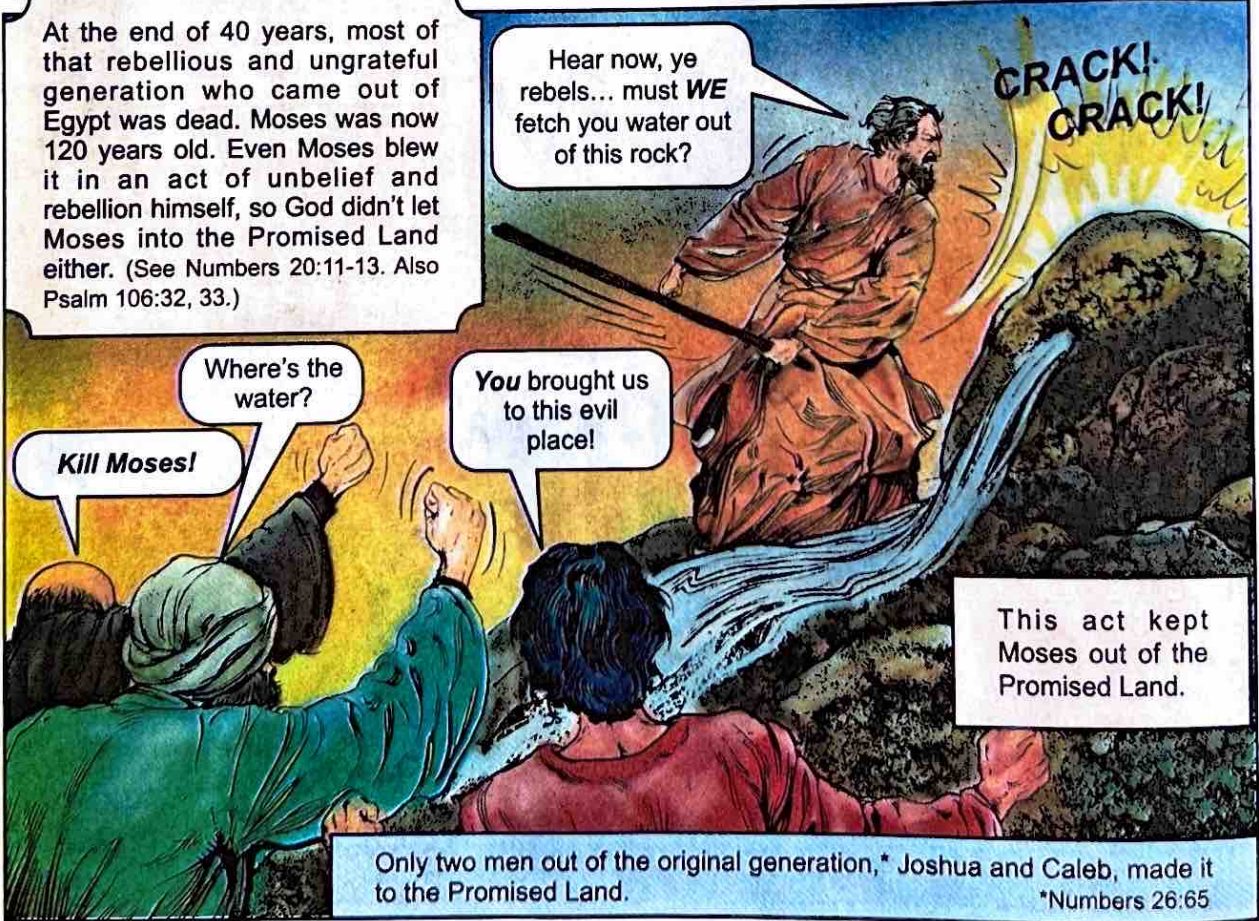
They cried to Moses for help. They were so scared they asked God and Moses to forgive them. So the Lord told Moses to make a serpent of brass and put it on a pole and lift it up for the people to see.

No, it's a trick!  
Look and live!  
I don't believe him. **Augh!** I'm dying!

When anyone who was bitten looked at that brass serpent on the pole, he would live.\*  
\*Numbers 21:8,9

The brass serpent was a picture of Christ made sin for us in the future, on the cross.  
(John 3:14)

At the end of 40 years, most of that rebellious and ungrateful generation who came out of Egypt was dead. Moses was now 120 years old. Even Moses blew it in an act of unbelief and rebellion himself, so God didn't let Moses into the Promised Land either. (See Numbers 20:11-13. Also Psalm 106:32, 33.)



Hear now, ye rebels... must **WE** fetch you water out of this rock?

**CRACK!  
CRACK!**

Where's the water?  
**Kill Moses!**  
You brought us to this evil place!

This act kept Moses out of the Promised Land.

Only two men out of the original generation,\* Joshua and Caleb, made it to the Promised Land.  
\*Numbers 26:65



Moses died, and now it was time for Joshua to lead the second generation of Israelites into the Promised Land. They had become an army, and their job was to wipe out the evil people living in the Holy Land, and to clean it from idols and false gods.\*

\*Deuteronomy 7:1-10



The people living there were filled with syphilis and all kinds of diseases. Their animals were infected too. People offered their children in human sacrifices to their gods. God did not want the children of Israel contaminated by their filth. God demanded total separation from those people, to protect the Israelites.

After the Israelites crossed over the River Jordan, Joshua spent the rest of his life leading them in constant warfare with the inhabitants of the land.





When Joshua died, Israel rebelled against God. The Israelites went into spiritual darkness. Every man did that which was right in his own eyes... Satan was laughing at God's Chosen People who stopped fighting their enemies, and inter-married with tribes who worshipped the devil.

God let Israel fall into slavery but when they wept and repented and asked God to save them...

Jewish pigs... we'll show you how to suffer!

Oh, God, help us!

The Lord would raise up men and women\* who would lead them out of slavery and back to serving the Lord again. As soon as that leader died, Israel would become rebellious again. \*Judges 4:4

The children of Israel didn't want God to rule them but demanded a king like all the other nations. So God gave them kings. Throughout their history only a very few of their leaders really obeyed God.

David was the greatest of all their kings, and Satan almost destroyed David with a woman named Bathsheba.\* But David broke before the Lord, repented, and was forgiven. The history of the kings of Israel and Judah is one of almost total disaster.

\*II Samuel chapters 11 & 12

Our new king is worse than the last one.

Out of the great numbers of Jews, God always had a small remnant\* who loved and obeyed Him... it was through certain loyal ones that God directed the writing of the books of the Bible. \*Small number of people

**Interesting note:** Satan was so powerful that if he'd had his way, Israel would have become like the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah. (Isaiah 1:9)

Thank God for the small number of believers that are faithful. That is the only thing that holds back God's awful judgment. (Just like today.)



God made certain conditions in His laws... He said He would bless Israel if they obeyed Him... if not, they would suffer. (Read Leviticus, Chapter 26. You can almost see Hitler's Holocaust in that chapter.)



God finally gave them up and the Israelites were carried to Babylon where they suffered for 70 years\* before a remnant went back to Jerusalem.

\*Jeremiah 25:11, 12

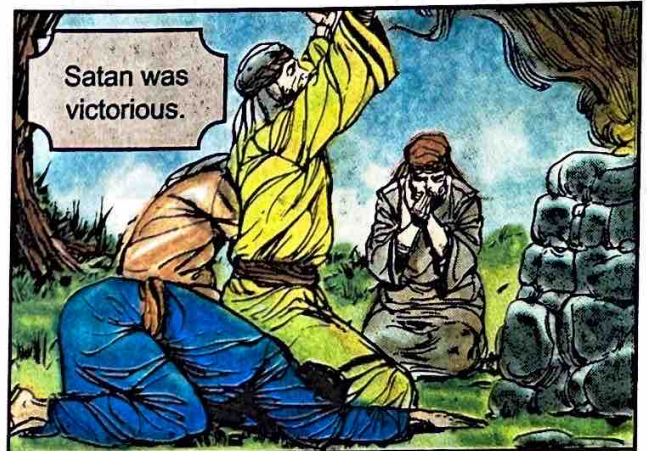
During this time God spoke to them through His prophets.



Serves him right!

Nobody's going to tell *us* what to do!

But for the most part, they hated their prophets. They killed most of them and served the devil instead. This was the picture of God's Chosen People in the Old Testament part of the Bible.



Satan was victorious.

Only a handful were faithful.\* Yet God, in His love, didn't forget them. He was about to send His only Son from heaven like His prophets said He would. \*(Isaiah 10:20-22, Zephaniah 3:13)

**This closes the Old Testament portion of the Bible.**

From the time of Adam until the close of the Old Testament, millions had died. Where is their final destination? It's a terrible picture.

**When Satan was thrown out of heaven, God prepared hell for the devil and his fallen angels\*... and all those who rebelled against God!\*\***

\*Matthew 25:41

\*\*Psalm 9:17

Only those few who obeyed God would miss it.

The number two Person in the Godhead... the Lord Jesus was now ready to leave heaven and come to this planet to be sacrificed for the sins of the world.

**The thing Satan most dreaded was about to happen.**



# New Testament

Everyone was afraid of Roman soldiers. Jerusalem was under their absolute control. Israel was a beaten nation. Trodden down under the Greeks, the Persians, and now Rome. The armies of Rome were everywhere.

\*The Jews know that the "Messiah" is God coming in the form of a man, to save Israel from all their suffering. He will be their hero and rule the world.

Roman soldiers stationed in the Holy Land hated the Jews and their strange customs. Like today, life was cheap... those were dark days.

The Jewish high priest was on the take. He was the great spiritual leader and a real phoney. He belonged to a secret society that believed in the Cabala\* instead of the Holy Scriptures.

He had great wealth and power. He took his orders from Rome. The Jews were allowed to keep their religion. It was easier to rule them this way.

\*Occult mysticism (numerology, astrology, etc.) learned at the seat of false religion in Babylon. (This was learned during the Jew's captivity there hundreds of years earlier, and by this time it had totally permeated Judaism.)

Rome had made Herod king over the Jews. It was his job to see that the Jews didn't riot or make waves. Herod was a shrewd politician, and a monster!



Herod had ordered the great Jewish temple to be rebuilt in Jerusalem. In doing that, he tried to get the Jews to like him.


Caesar Augustus, the Emperor of Rome, ridiculed Herod by saying, "It's better to be his hog than his son."\*\* Herod had murdered one of his wives and his son. He only did things like that when someone upset him.

Something was in the wind that was going to upset Herod *very* much!

The angel, Gabriel, leaves heaven on his biggest assignment, heading for the planet, earth... immediately, the forces of darkness spot him coming into their territory. "...Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife:

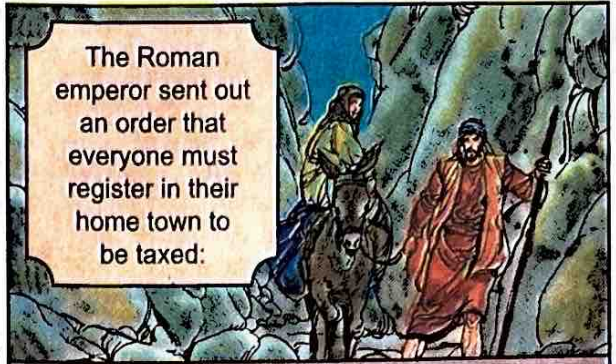
for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

God told him in a dream to marry her because her baby is the Saviour. So he did. Bible prophecy said that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem.

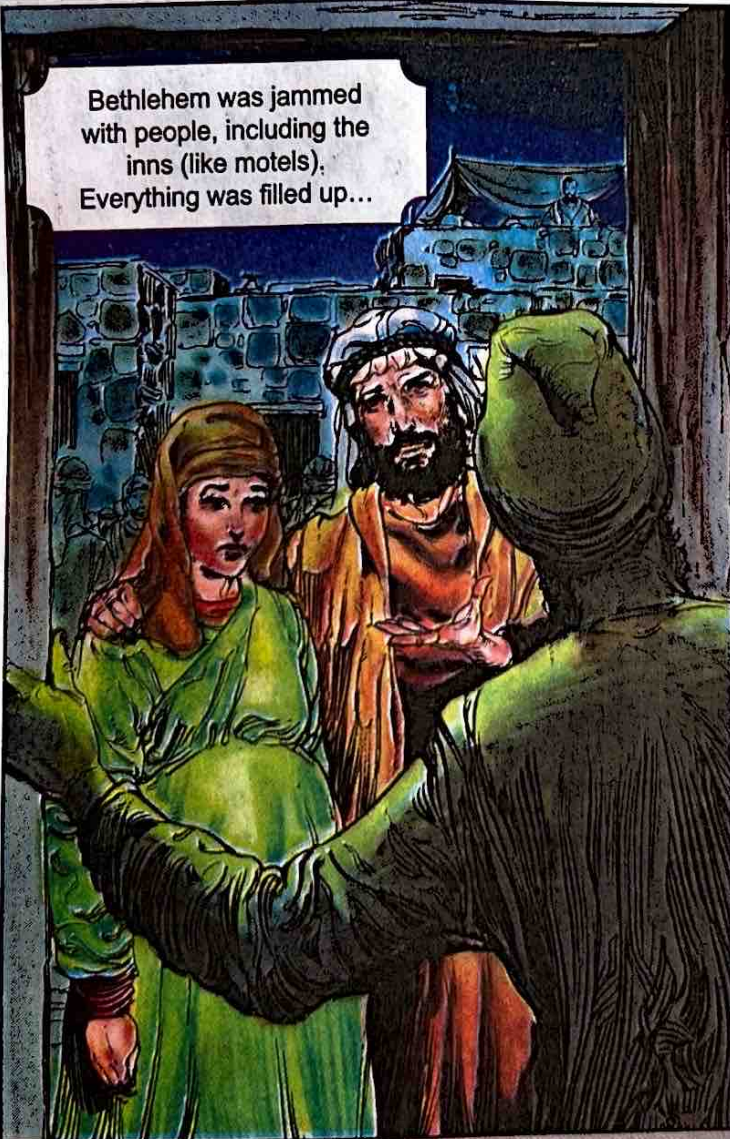
The Roman emperor sent out an order that everyone must register in their home town to be taxed:



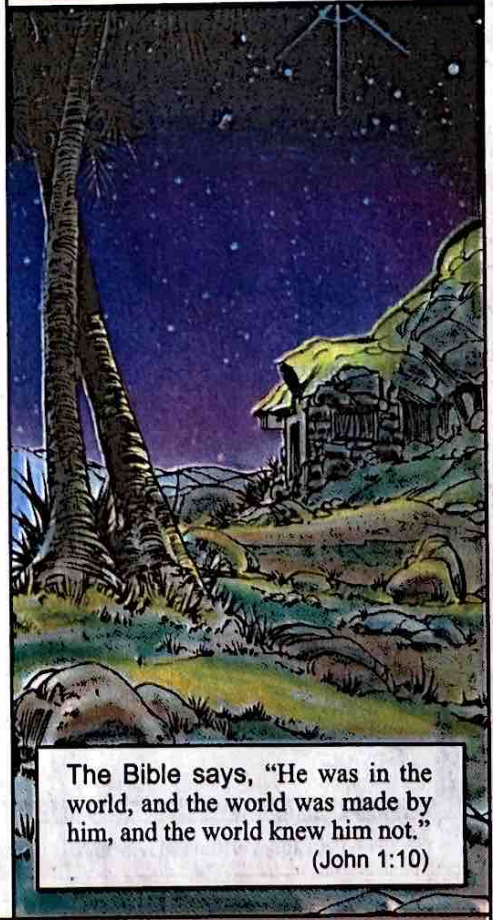
Mary's husband was born in Bethlehem, so while she was in the final stages of pregnancy, she must travel 80 dangerous miles to fulfill this prophecy.

Bethlehem was jammed with people, including the inns (like motels). Everything was filled up...





\*See The Crusaders, volume 8, *The Gift*. \*\* Luke 1:46-48



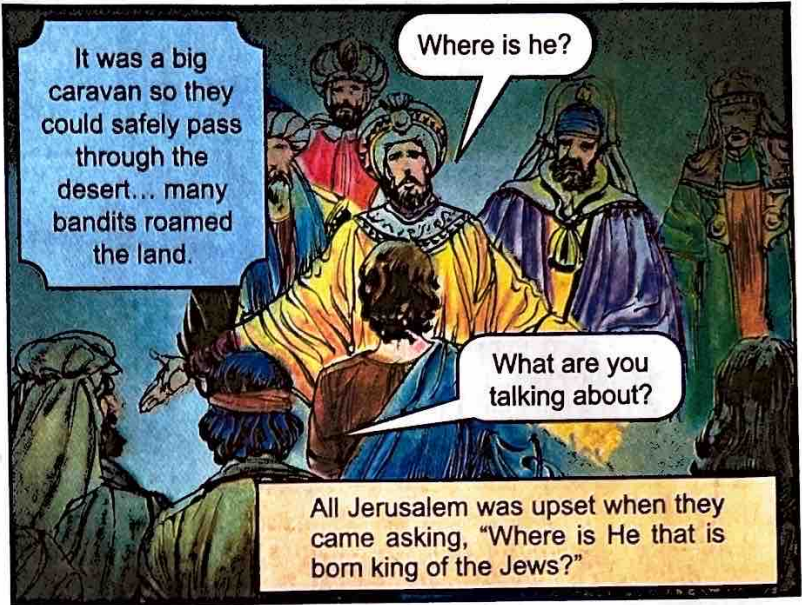
So being a faithful servant of God, Mary fulfilled her obligation. (Luke 2:39)

Wise Men from the east saw a strange star in the heavens and they followed it to the city of Jerusalem. (Matt. 2:1, 2)

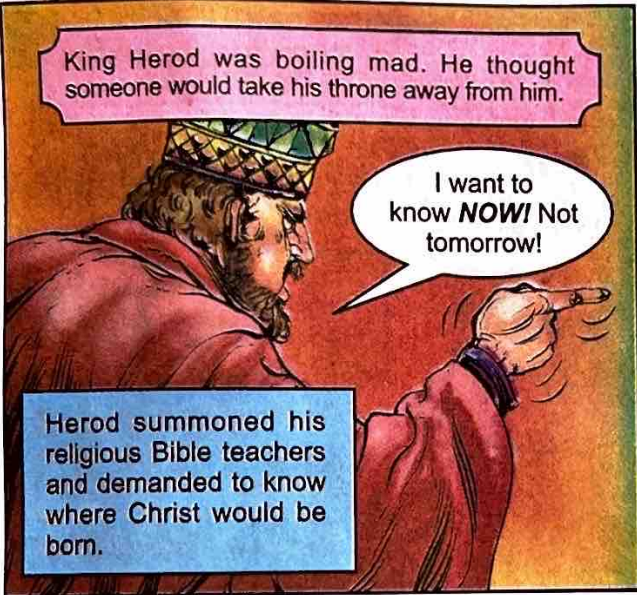


It was a big caravan so they could safely pass through the desert... many bandits roamed the land.

What are you talking about?

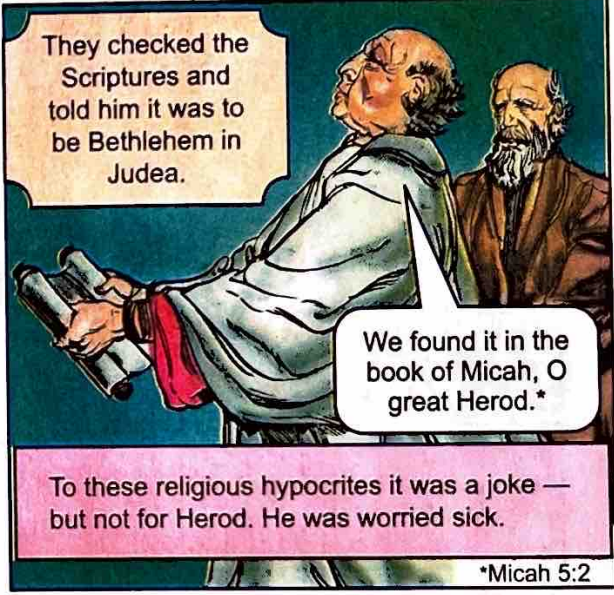
All Jerusalem was upset when they came asking, "Where is He that is born king of the Jews?"

Herod summoned his religious Bible teachers and demanded to know where Christ would be born.



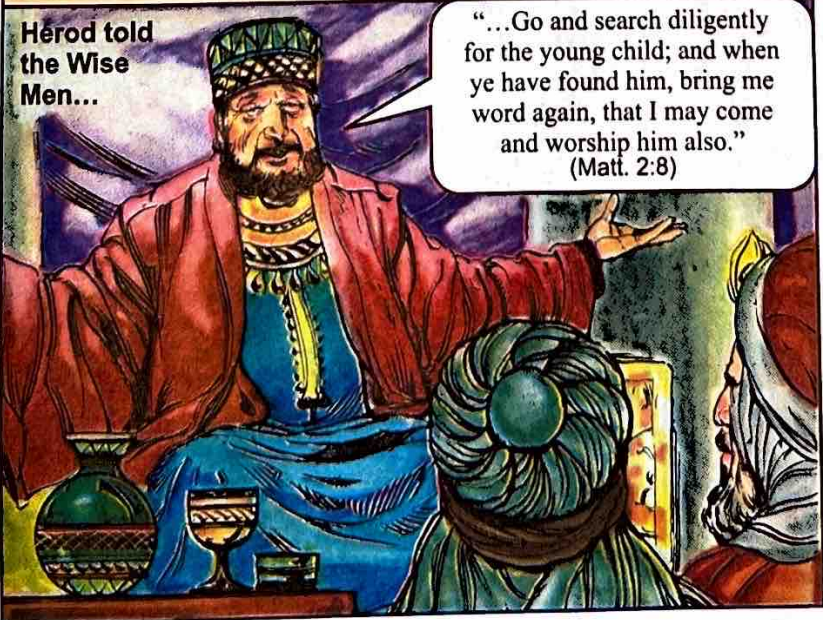
They checked the Scriptures and told him it was to be Bethlehem in Judea.

To these religious hypocrites it was a joke — but not for Herod. He was worried sick.

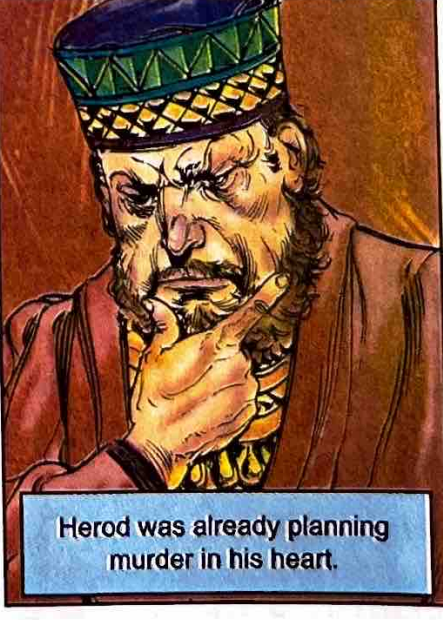

Herod asked the Wise Men when they first saw the star. They told him a date that would make Jesus about 18 months old.



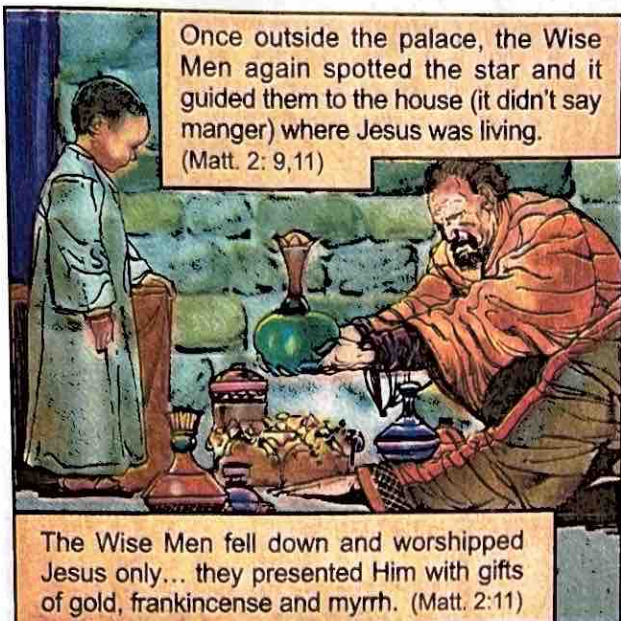
Herod told the Wise Men...

The Wise Men fell down and worshipped Jesus only... they presented Him with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. (Matt. 2:11)

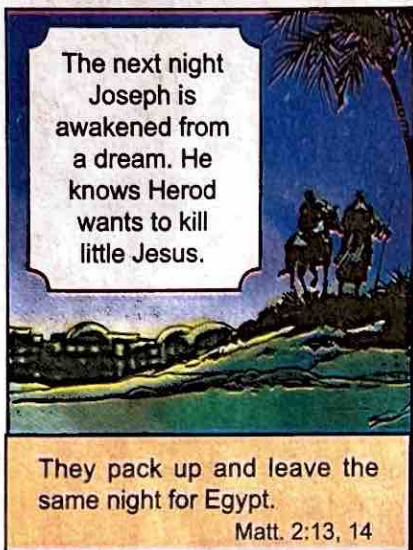


Joseph, we had a dream\*... we were told not to return to Herod.

They pack up and leave the same night for Egypt. Matt. 2:13, 14

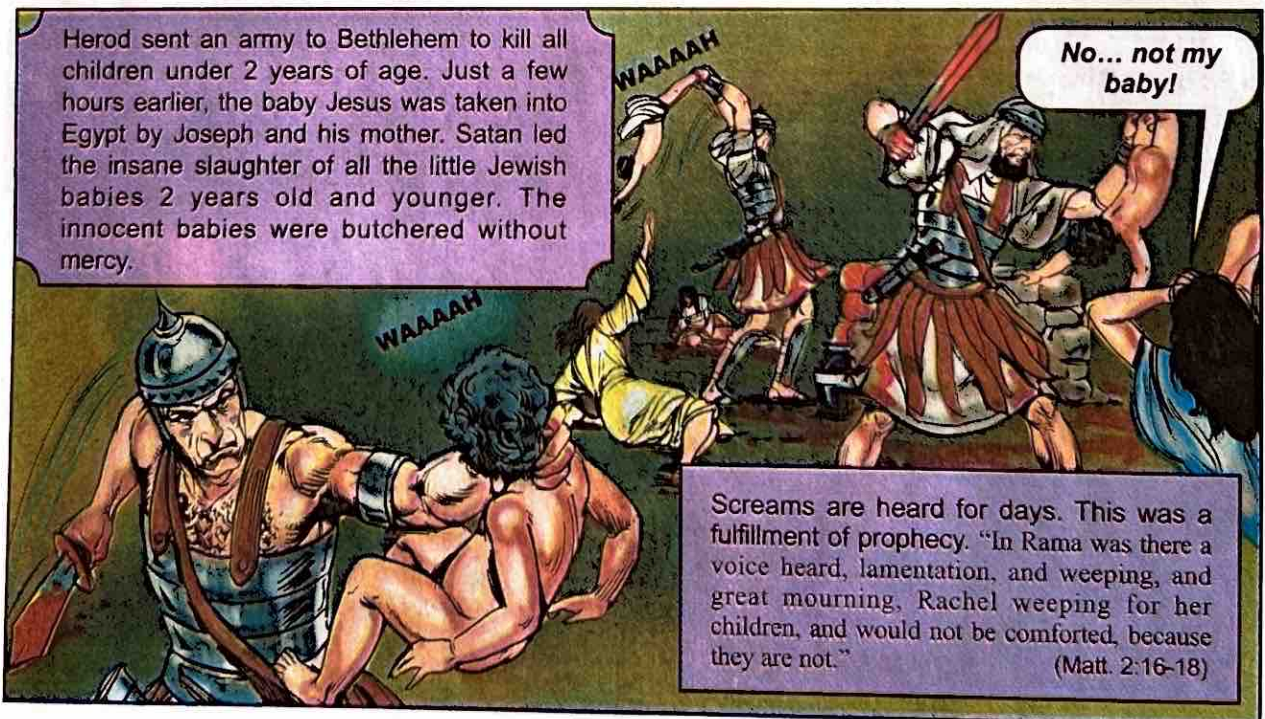


Herod finds out that the Wise Men are gone\*... he is furious... Satan now moves again to murder Jesus! \*Matt. 2:16

That's what I'll do!



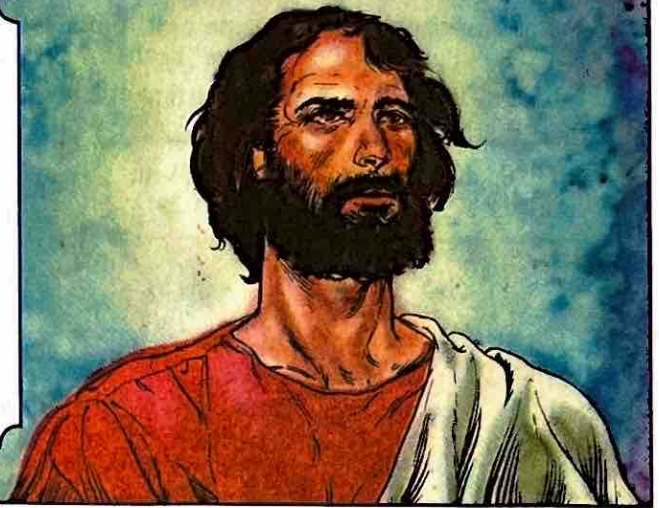

Satan led the insane slaughter of all the little Jewish babies 2 years old and younger. The innocent babies were butchered without mercy.

No... not my baby!

Screams are heard for days. This was a fulfillment of prophecy. "In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping for her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not." (Matt. 2:16-18)



Remember how the Holy Spirit came upon Mary before she was married to Joseph and how this holy Child was called the Son of God? The Creator of the universe had become flesh. He was different from any person born on this earth. The Bible says: "(Jesus) **WHO DID NO SIN**, neither was guile found in his mouth" (I Peter 2:22; II Cor. 5:21). How does this youth know so much about Jewish law?

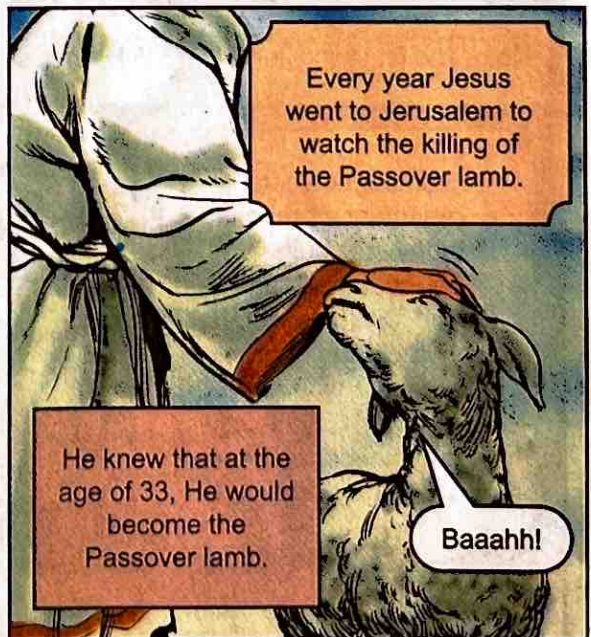
It was easy... about 1,500 years before that time, Jesus had given the Jewish law to Moses on Mt. Sinai.\*

Baaahh!

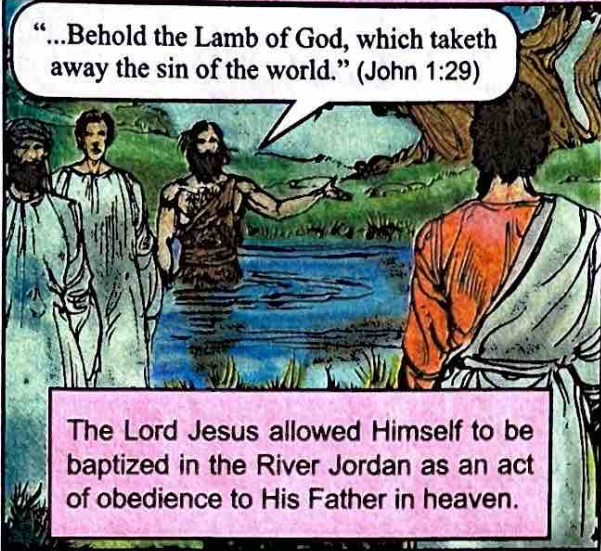




Jesus never spoke against Rome or its brutal rule of the Jewish people... but being God, His concern was the spiritual condition of Israel, and it was almost zero.

He began His public ministry at the age of 30. Watch carefully as He is introduced by John the Baptist:

"...Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world." (John 1:29)



The Lord Jesus allowed Himself to be baptized in the River Jordan as an act of obedience to His Father in heaven.

He was led by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness where He fasted (went without food) for 40 days. During this time, Satan tried every trick in the book to get Jesus to fall down and worship him...



"...All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me."\*\*

"...Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve."\*\*\*

Note: The first thing Jesus says in His ministry:

\*Repent means to stop running your own life. Ask God to forgive the way you've messed up by sinning. Be truly sorry, stop sinning and start obeying God.

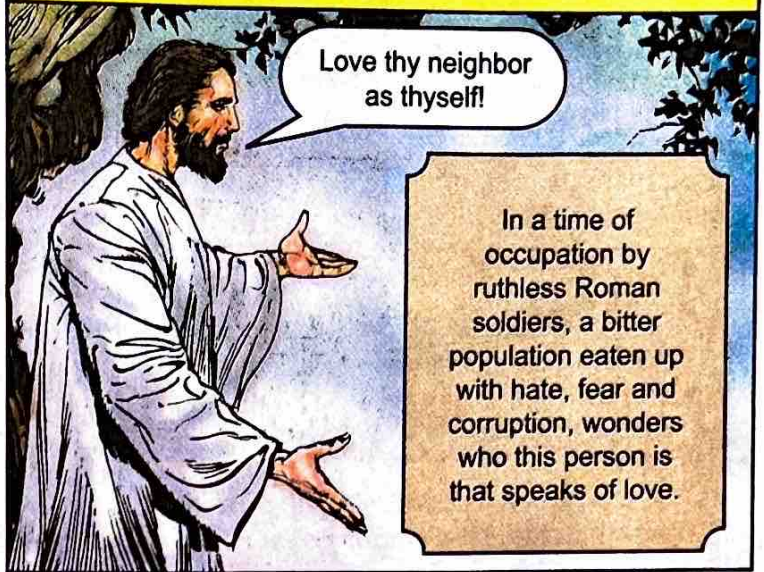


12 disciples are chosen.

Jesus healed the sick, cast out demons and raised some from the dead. He taught the people a new way to live.

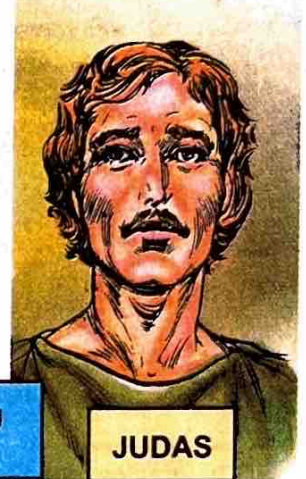


Love thy neighbor as thyself!

In a time of occupation by ruthless Roman soldiers, a bitter population eaten up with hate, fear and corruption, wonders who this person is that speaks of love.

Jesus' closest enemy was His friend,\* Judas... a very religious follower of Christ, appointed an apostle. Judas prayed, he preached the Gospel,\*\* healed the sick and cast out demons\*\*\* in the name of Jesus,† and he preached that men should repent. He was the world's greatest traitor all through his ministry with Christ. He set a pattern for the church... here is the pattern: 1 of the 12 disciples was a traitor... I believe that ratio (1 traitor to 12 Christians) could apply to the church today, including church members, pastors, evangelists, etc. The whole world is in rebellion against God, and Satan is taking them all to hell. So Satan's main target is Bible-believing Christians. (That's why there are so many Bible-believing Judases with us today.)

O God, I thank you that I am so holy and not like these miserable, unlearned and unclean sinners.

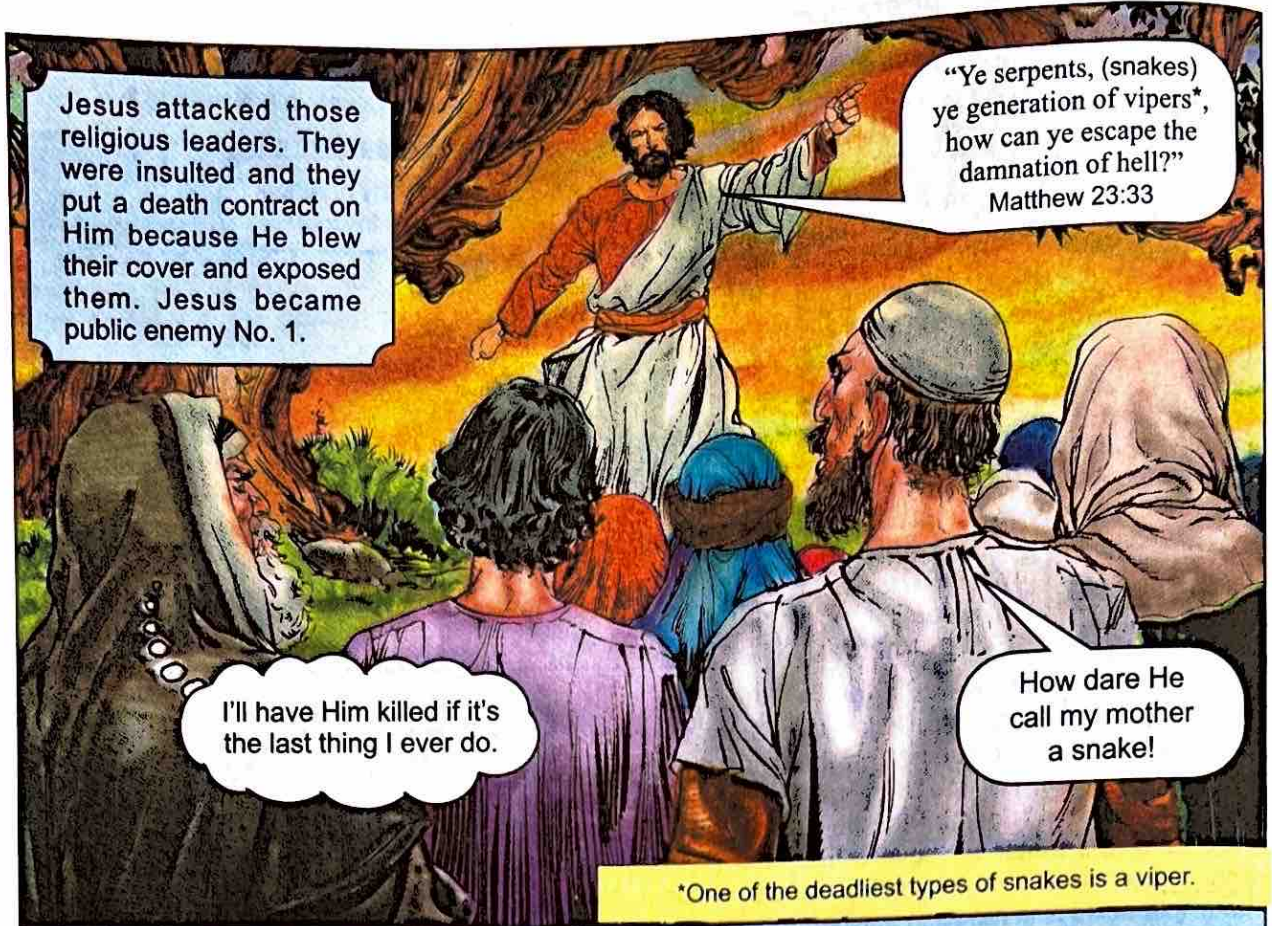
I am blessed just to be near him.

The Last Supper takes place in a house. Jesus broke the bread and said...

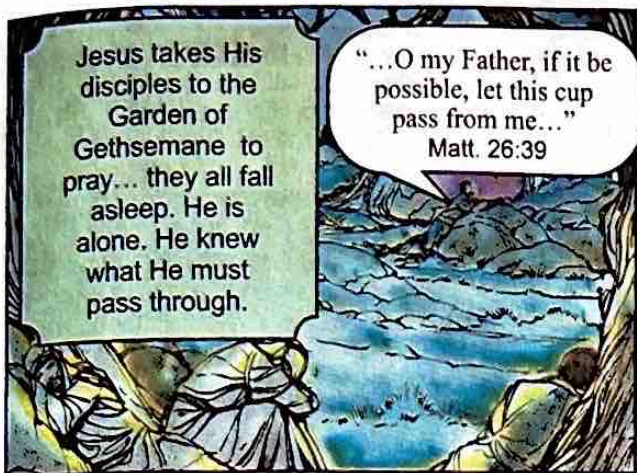


This is my body broken for you.

The bread didn't change into another Christ like the Roman Catholic institution claims,\* because it was still bread, to be eaten as a remembrance\*\* of His death until He comes again.

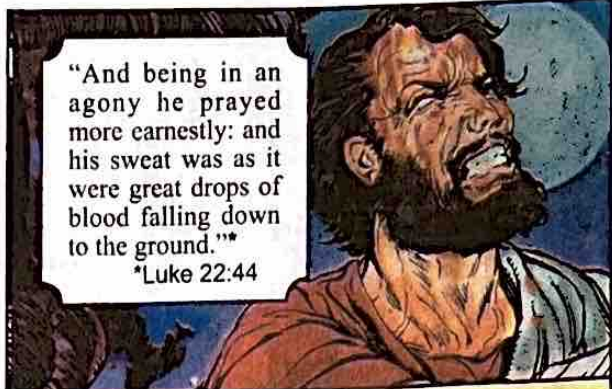

Jesus takes His disciples to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray... they all fall asleep. He is alone. He knew what He must pass through.

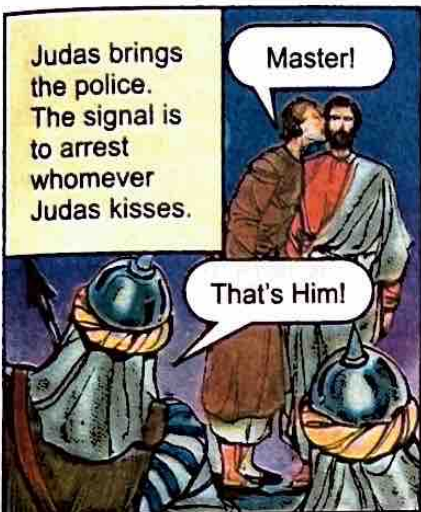

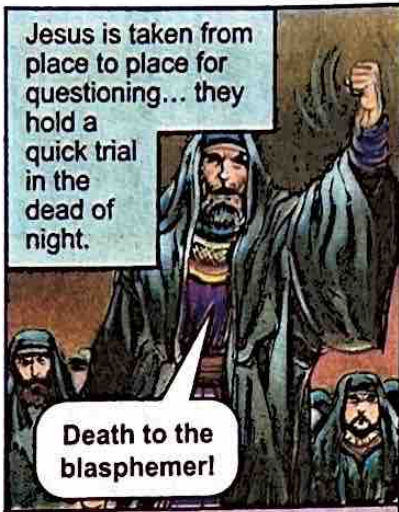


Judas brings the police. The signal is to arrest whomever Judas kisses.

The Jewish supreme court (Sanhedrin) finds Him guilty even before the trial... it's a stacked deck!

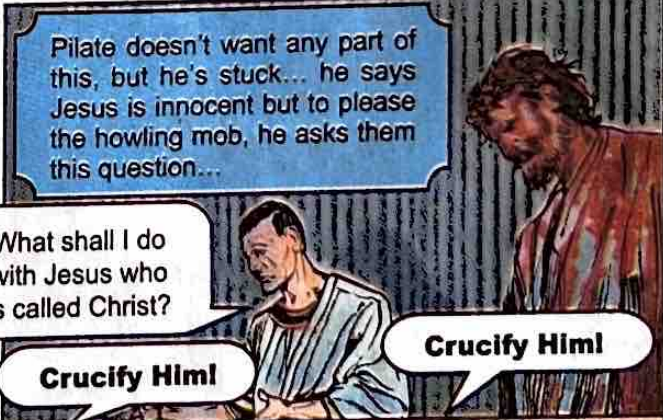


Jesus is beaten and spit upon by the strong, armed men of... Annas, Caiaphas and Herod (Antipas... the son of Herod the Great).

Crucify Him!

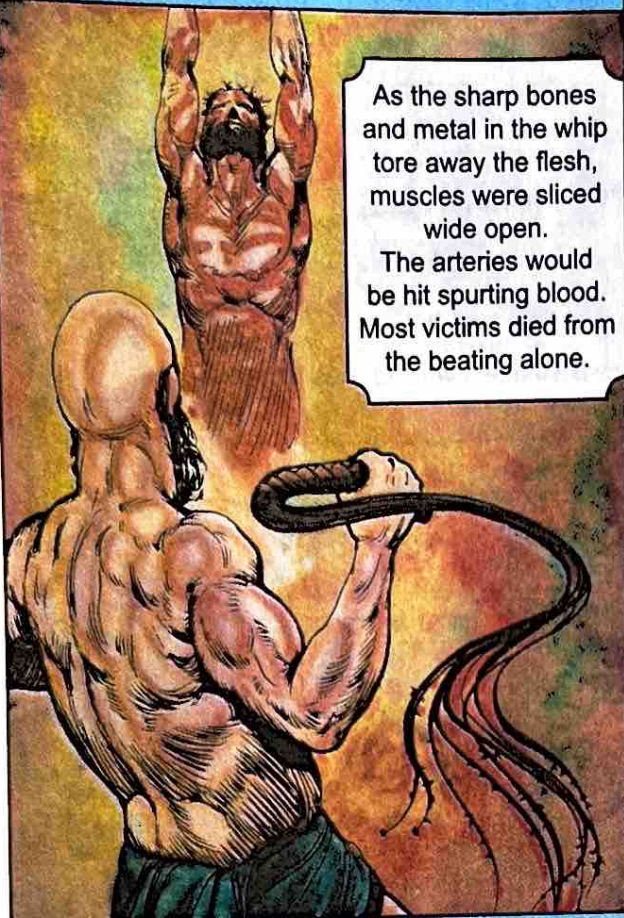
Crucify Him!

The angels of God watch in utter shock as they see their Creator humiliated, tortured and murdered.



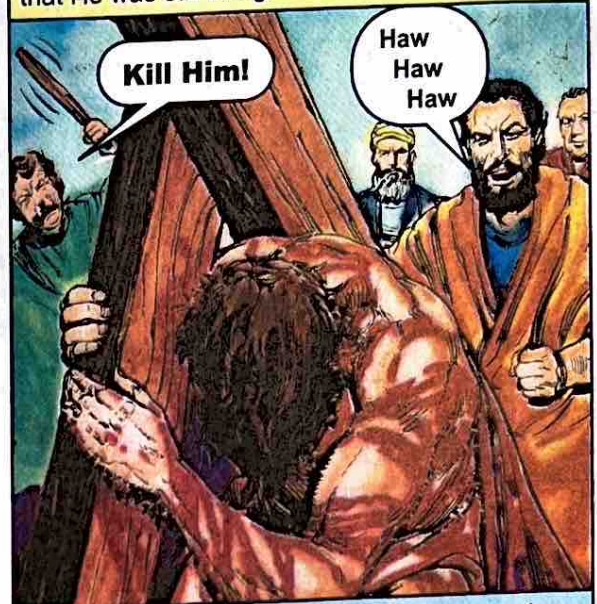
Pontius Pilate orders Jesus scourged (beaten).

As the sharp bones and metal in the whip tore away the flesh, muscles were sliced wide open. The arteries would be hit spurting blood. Most victims died from the beating alone.



The prophet Isaiah said, "...his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men." Isaiah 52:14

His flesh is hanging in ribbons as He is ordered to carry a cross weighing over 100 pounds, 650 yards to the place of execution... (Golgotha) the rough wood gouged into His torn back, by now He was already dehydrated. The miracle was that He was still living.

The sky is darkened for 3 hours as every filthy act ever done by man is heaped upon the precious Savior.



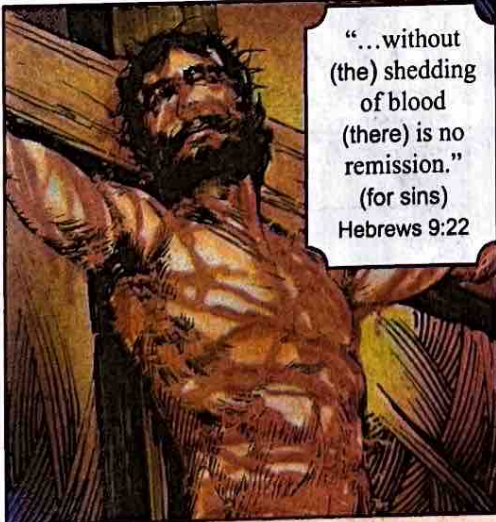
Then He said: "...Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost." Luke 23:46

Satan believes he did this with his power! He is overjoyed... his hated enemy is dead!

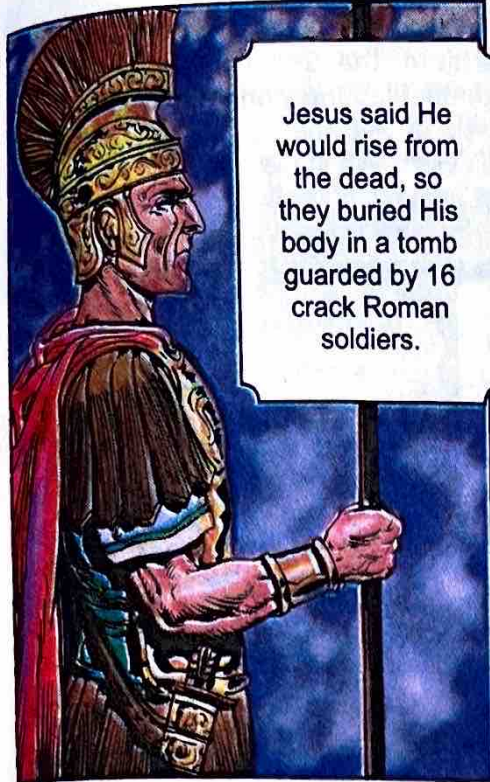

Jesus said He would rise from the dead, so they buried His body in a tomb guarded by 16 crack Roman soldiers.

The seal of Rome was placed on the huge stone blocking the grave entrance. If anyone broke that seal... the Roman F.B.I. and C.I.A. would hunt for them and then crucify them upside down.



No problem with the disciples... they were scared to death... their Leader was dead... the last thing the religious Jewish leaders wanted, was to hear of Jesus' resurrection.

On the first day of the week, there was a great earthquake and an angel descended from heaven and rolled the one ton stone away... the Roman soldiers were so frightened, they became as dead men.\*

Jesus arose from the dead... the tomb was empty... Satan was defeated!

If only one man fell asleep on guard duty, their whole group would be burned alive in their own clothing... so nobody so much as yawned.

Jesus was seen by over 500 witnesses!\*



\*From a historical or legal perspective, if there are enough people alive when the facts are published about an event and these people have either been eyewitnesses of it or had participated in it, it can be fairly well established the validity of a secular event.

When His cowering disciples saw Him, they were transformed into vibrant, aggressive men who were on fire for God!

As He went into heaven, the disciples stood watching in amazement. Two angels appeared and said to them...

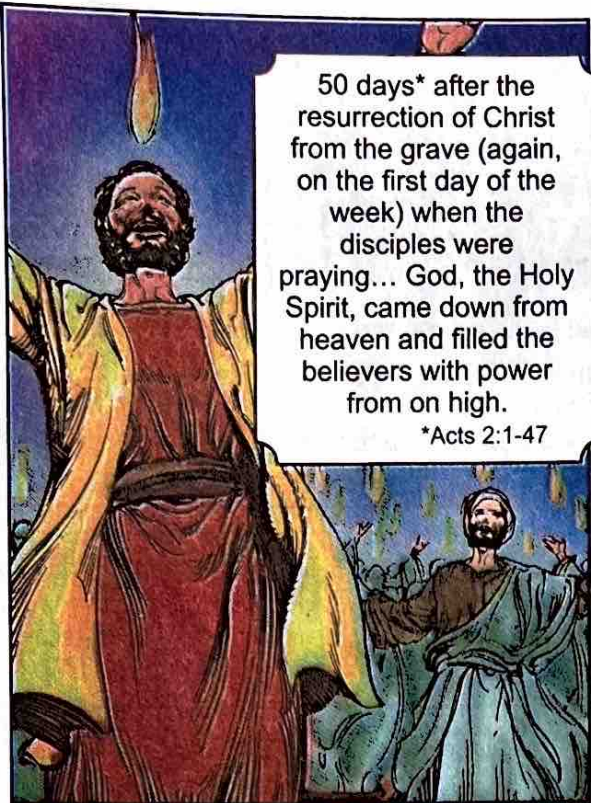
"Why stand ye gazing\* up into heaven? This same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven."

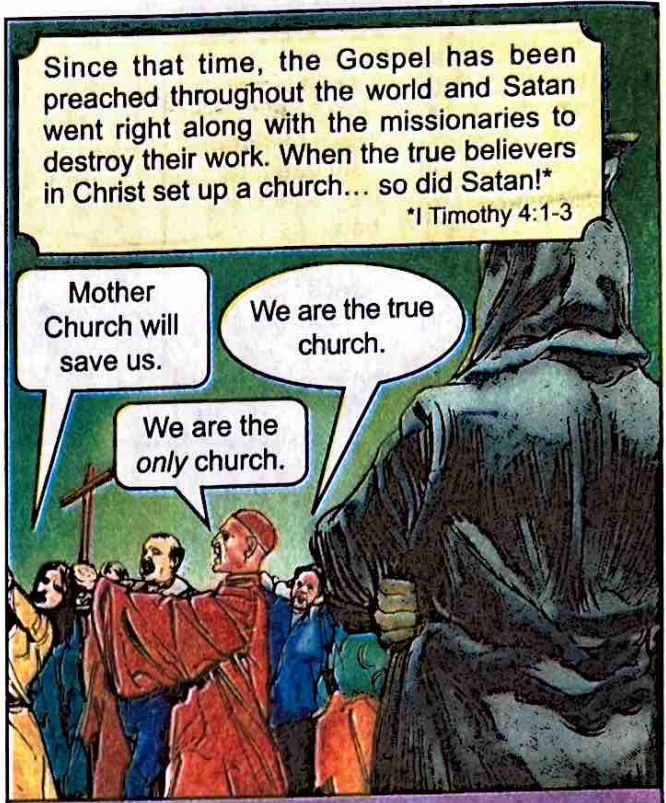
Now watch what is coming upon the earth. It could happen in your lifetime.

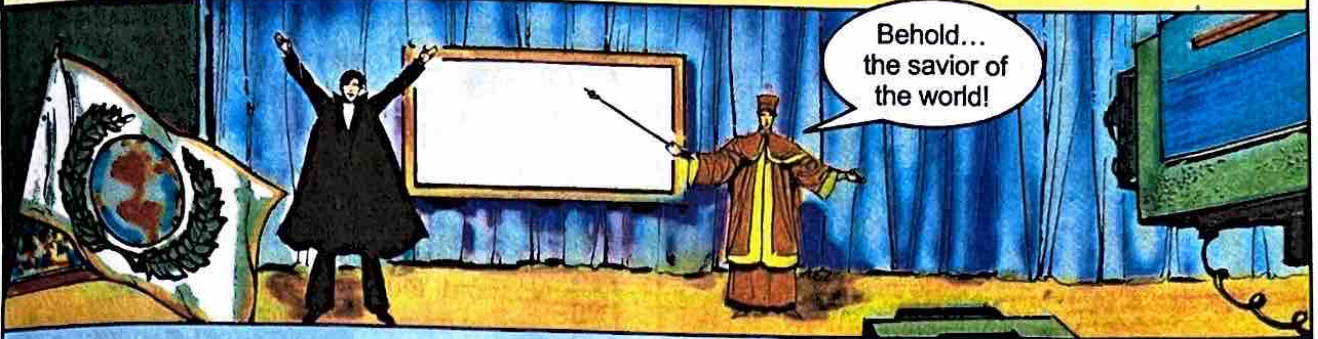

I looked and I actually saw the nail prints in our Messiah's hands!

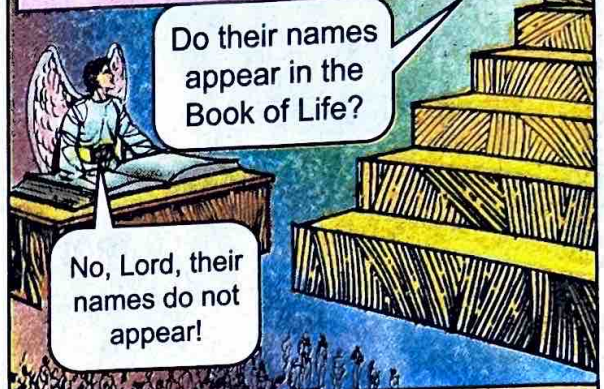
