

How Did Jesus Display His Love to us By Dying on the Cross?

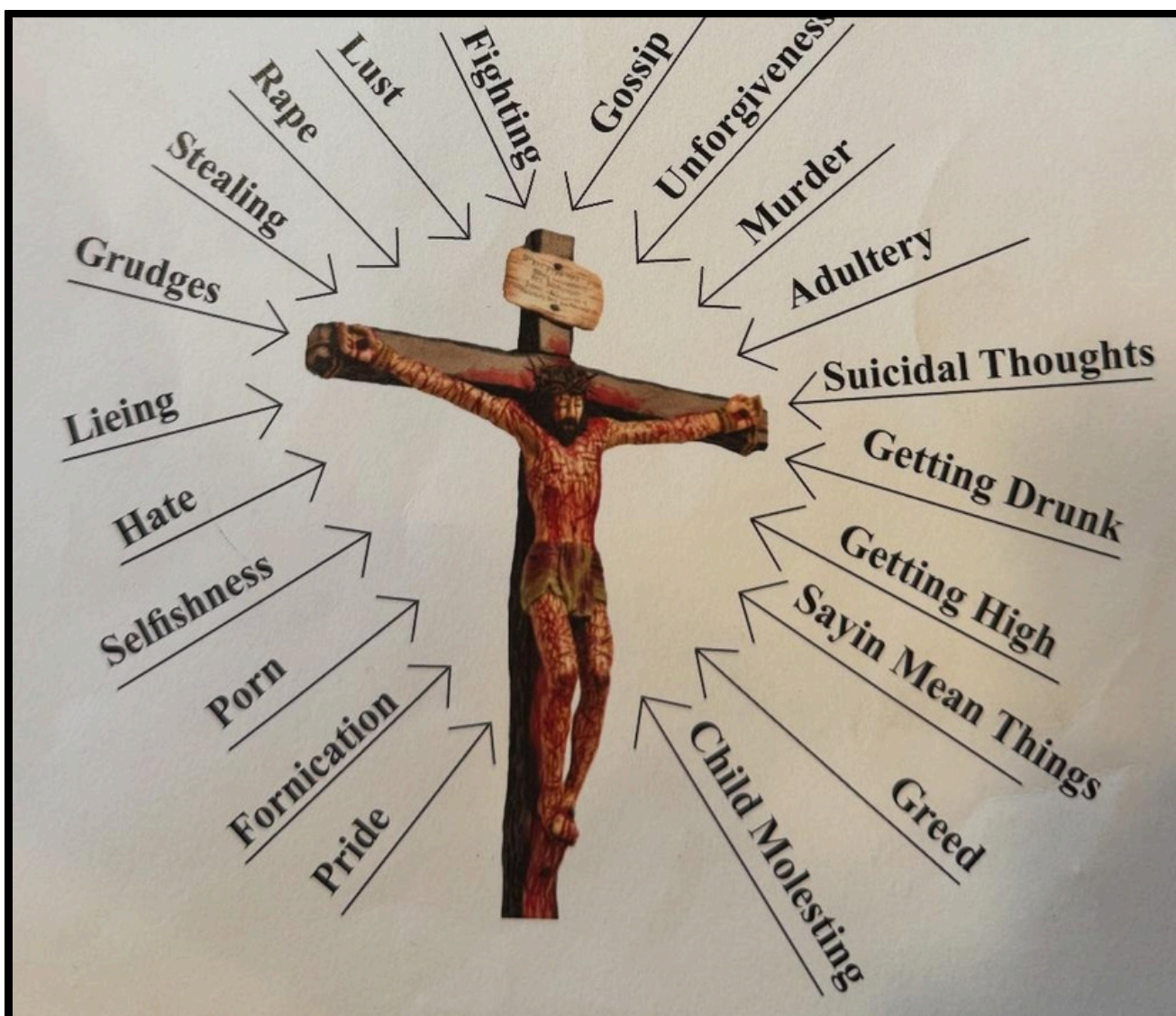
He transferred the Sins of the Whole World (Past, Present, Future) onto this Body on the Cross.

2 Corinthians 5:17 - He, Jesus who experience no Sin, became Sin on our behalf, that we might become the righteousness of God.

Mark 15:34 - Jesus said, "My God why have you forsaken me." Because taking on the Accumulative Filth, He had to momentarily turn His back on Jesus.

Jesus Loves us so much that He took onto His Body, all the Accumulative Filth of the Whole World (Every Rape, Every Murder, Every Child Moledstation, Every Hate, Every Adultery, and Every Kind of Sin was transferred onto His Body on the Cross.)

1 John 1:8: If we say we have no sin, we deceived ourselves and the truth is not in us

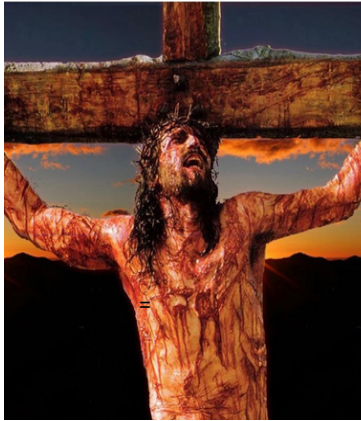
(A) Isaiah 53:50- By His Scourging or Stripes we are healed

The whip had Balls of Metal in it that would Deeply Bruise The Flesh. And also pieces of Glass that would Tear off the Flesh.

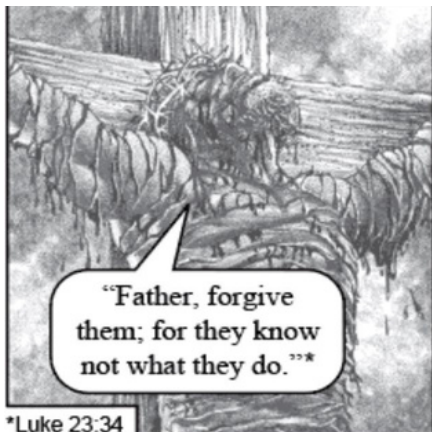
-Sickness was and Death was part of the Punishment for our sins (or the Sin)
